

Review Questions

1. What is a false prophet or teacher? *Someone who teaches things about God that are not found in the Bible.*
2. What did God warn would happen to false prophets? *They would die.*
3. If someone spoke to the people in the name of the Lord and said something would happen, but it didn't, was he a true prophet or a false prophet? *False prophet.*
4. How would you know a true prophet of God? *What he said would actually happen!*
5. What do false teachers and false religions do to God's Word? *They change it. They add their own ideas. They take away from it.*
6. The Bible warns that there are two things we should never do to change God's Word. What are they? *Add to it or take something away from it.*
7. Remember the play dough? What will happen if we listen to false teachers and their ideas? *False ideas get mixed in with our beliefs, and it becomes confusing and hard to know what the truth really is.*
8. If we hear someone teaching about God, and it doesn't sound right, what should we do? *Check what the Bible says.*
9. What does the word "gospel" mean? *Good news.*
10. Who is the gospel about? *Jesus.*
11. Who is Jesus? *God's Son. The second Person of the Trinity.*
12. How do we know that anyone who tries to add to God's Word is a false prophet? What has God said about His Word? Is it complete or does it need more added to it? *It is complete.*
13. What is the only book we can rely on to always tell us the truth? *The Bible.*
14. Can you name a true prophet from the Bible? *Moses, Jeremiah, Isaiah, Ezekiel, Micah, etc.*
15. Who can recite the memory verse? *Have several students recite the verse.*
