

Review Questions

1. What Scriptures did Jesus have to study and teach from? *The Old Testament. Moses and the Prophets.*
2. Name one of the five books of Moses in the Old Testament. *Allow several students to answer. Genesis, Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers, Deuteronomy.*
3. Jesus used the Old Testament to explain to the disciples about whom? *Himself, the Messiah.*
4. Who was the famous prophet we talked about today? *Jeremiah.*
5. Who did Jeremiah speak for? *God.*
6. What was the name of the scribe who helped Jeremiah? *Baruch.*
7. What did the scribe Baruch do for the prophet Jeremiah? *He wrote down what Jeremiah told him.*
8. Where did Baruch write down the words Jeremiah gave him? *On a scroll.*
9. The people were wicked and sinful. What was Jeremiah's message from God to them? *A warning of judgment.*
10. What did King Jehoiakim do to the scroll containing God's warning? *He cut it up and threw it in the fire.*
11. Why did King Jehoiakim try to destroy God's Word? *He didn't want to turn from his sin or hear that God would judge him.*
12. Did King Jehoiakim succeed in destroying God's Word? Why or why not? *He didn't succeed because God gave the words again to Jeremiah.*
13. What has God promised about His Word? *It will never be destroyed.*
14. What is the memory verse we are learning? *2 Timothy 3:16–17.*
15. Based on 2 Timothy 3:16–17, what are some ways the Scriptures help us? **There are four listed in the passage.** *Allow several students to answer. Teaching (doctrine), reproof, correction, and training in righteousness.*
