

Real World Skit

Two students discussing the truth found in the Bible.

Student 1: I really like knowing that Jesus is our Savior and died for us. And we will one day get to heaven.

Student 2: Me too! But there are other ways to get to heaven besides Jesus.

Student 1: Huh? What are you talking about?

Student 2: Like people who believe in Buddha. Or people who believe in God, but they don't believe in Jesus. They can get to heaven, too.

Student 1: How can they get to heaven? What do you mean?

Student 2: As long as they are good people. You know, they are nice to others and give their money to help people. God wouldn't send nice people to hell.

Student 1: So, where's that in the Bible? I don't remember reading it.

Student 2: I don't think I actually read that. But my next-door neighbor was telling me that God is love and that He just wouldn't send nice people to hell. I think my neighbor is right!

Student 1: Wait a minute! Just because someone says something is true doesn't mean it is true. We need to look at what the Bible says and what Jesus Himself said!

Student 2: OK. So, what did Jesus say?

Student 1: Jesus said that HE is the way, the truth, and the life. No one can get to God or to heaven without believing in Him.

Student 2: I remember reading that. But what about all of those nice people?

Student 1: The Bible says that no one is good enough. We have all sinned. And if people don't receive Jesus like the Bible says, if they don't ask Him for forgiveness of their sins and believe in Him alone for salvation, they will not get to heaven. Jesus died so we could be saved. If we could get to heaven by being "nice," He wouldn't have had to die at all because that would mean we could do it on our own.
