

2 Cor 5:18 ... who has reconciled us to Himself through Jesus Christ, ...

4. We are Exalted 5. Cor 5:20 Now then, we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were pleading through us: we implore you on Christ's behalf, be reconciled to God. Rev 1:6 and has made us kings and priests to His God and Father,

1 Pet 2:5,9 you also, as living stones, are being built up a spiritual house, a holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ. ... ⁹ But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light;

In Israel, the priests were the mediators between God and the people. (Ex 19 – Moses on Mt. Sinai)
