Jesus was crucified on the Cross, the perfect sacrifice for sin.




Consummation



Genesis 1:1

In the beginning God created the
heaven and the earth.

Genesis 1:3

And God said, Let there be light: and there was light.

Genesis 1:5

And God called the light Day, and the darkness he called Night. And the evening and the morning were the first day.



God created day and night, dark and light.

Class Notes

1) God said, "Let there be light." He separated the light from the darkness. This was the first day and night.

Genesis 1:6

And God said, Let there be a firmament in the midst of the waters, and let it divide the waters from the waters.



God separated the waters
and created the sky and air.

2) God created the expanse and the air we breathe.

Genesis 1:9–10

9 And God said, Let the waters under the heaven be gathered together unto one place, and let the dry land appear: and it was so.

10 And God called the dry land Earth; and the gathering together of the waters called he Seas: and God saw that it was good.

Genesis 1:11

And God said, Let the earth bring forth grass, the herb yielding seed, and the fruit tree yielding fruit after his kind, whose seed is in itself, upon the earth: and it was so.




God created the land and the plants.

3) God created the land and all the plants that grow out of it.

Genesis 1:16

And God made two great lights; the greater light to rule the day, and the lesser light to rule the night: he made the stars also.



God created the sun, moon, stars, and planets.

God created:

4a) The greater light to rule the day.

It is the sun.

4b) The lesser light to rule the night.

It is the moon.

4c) All the stars. He spoke, and they appeared.




God created day and night, dark and light.

Genesis 1:20

And God said, Let the waters bring forth abundantly the moving creature that hath life, and fowl that may fly above the earth in the open firmament of heaven.

Class Notes

God created:

5a) Sea creatures—to fill the waters.

5b) Flying creatures—to fly above the earth and fill the sky.

Genesis 1:24

And God said, Let the earth bring forth the living creature after his kind, cattle, and creeping thing, and beast of the earth after his kind: and it was so.

Genesis 1:27

So God created man in his own image,
in the image of God created he him;
male and female created he them.



God created land animals
and made people very special—in His image.

God created:

6a) The land animals .

6b) And people —who are the ONLY ones created in God's image!

And then
GOD
rested.

God rested so we would rest, too.

Exodus 20:11

For in six days the Lord made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them is, and rested the seventh day: wherefore the Lord blessed the sabbath day, and hallowed it.


7) God rested. He wanted us to know that we would need a day to rest and worship Him.


