1. What does the Bible say happened “in the beginning”? *God created.*
2. How long ago did God create the heavens and the earth? *6,000 years ago.*
3. True or false: God created light before He created the sun. *True.*
4. What did God place the firmament, or the atmosphere, between? *The waters.*
5. What is one thing the firmament is made up of? We need it for life. *Air.*
6. What did God create on Day Three? *The dry land and plants.*
7. What did God call the waters He gathered together on Day Three? *The sea.*
8. What did God call the dry land, also created on Day Three? *Earth.*
9. What was the greater light that God created to rule the day? *The sun.*
10. What was the lesser light that God created to rule the night? *The moon.*
11. What else did God create to fill the heavens? *Planets, stars, galaxies.*
12. What did God create on Day Five? *Sea creatures and birds (flying creatures).*
13. What animals did God create on Day Six? *Land animals.*
14. What was God’s last creation during Creation Week? *Man. Adam and Eve.*
15. Man is not like any animal. What is special about man? *He is created in God’s image.*
16. Name something man can do which animals can’t. *Allow several students to answer. Have a relationship with God, think, create, love others, etc.*
17. What is the memory verse we are working on? *Psalms 8:3–4. Have several students read the verse.*
18. The memory verse talks about the moon and the stars. On what day of Creation Week were they created? *Day Four.*
