

Review Questions

1. How did God create everything in the universe? *By the power of His word. He spoke and it came to be.*
2. What did God create on Day Five? *Flying creatures (fowl) and sea creatures.*
3. Name an example of a flying creature. *Answers may include birds, bats, and flying reptiles.*
4. How long ago were creatures that are extinct today created? *Creatures like the plesiosaur? About 6,000 years ago during Creation Week.*
5. Can you name another extinct animal? *Allow several students to answer. Pteranodon, ichthyosaur, mosasaur, T. rex, triceratops, woolly mammoth, Apatosaurus, etc.*
6. What is the attribute the all-powerful Creator God displayed during Creation Week? *Omnipotence.*
7. On what day of Creation Week did God create dinosaurs such as *T. rex* and triceratops? *Day Six.*
8. What does it mean that God created animals after their kinds? *Animals will never turn into another kind of animal. They produce the same kind of animal.*
9. What did God create at the beginning of Day Six of Creation Week? *Land animals.*
10. Give an example of a land animal. *Allow several students to answer. Answers may include livestock (domestic animals and pets), beasts (wild animals, dinosaurs), and insects.*
11. What was God's very special, last creation on Day Six? *Man—male and female; Adam and Eve.*
12. How do evolutionists believe life began? *It slowly evolved from a single cell.*
13. Why is man God's special creation? *He is made in God's image.*
14. There is one very special thing that God has given people that animals can't have. What is that? *People can be saved and forgiven through Jesus Christ. People can have a relationship with God.*
15. What else makes people different from animals? *People can think, communicate, love, forgive, read, write, etc.*
16. What is the memory verse we are working on? *Psalm 8:3–4.*
17. According to Psalm 8:3–4, what has God ordained in the heavens? *The moon and the stars.*
