#### In Christ, we have peace with God

Rom 5:1 Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ.

Col 1:21-22 And you, who once were alienated and enemies in your mind by wicked works, yet now He has reconciled <sup>22</sup>in the body of His flesh through death,

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#### In Christ, we have the peace of God


Phil 4:7 and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

Col 3:15 And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to which also you were called in one body; and be thankful.

#### In Christ, we have peace with others

Rom 14:19 Therefore let us pursue the things which make for peace and the things by which one may edify another.

1 Cor 7:15 But God has called us to peace.



So, how can do we deal with Christmas "outlaws" - and any other outlaws for that matter?

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Rom 12:18-21 If it is possible, as much as depends on you, live peaceably with all men. <sup>19</sup>Beloved, do not avenge yourselves, but rather give place to wrath; for it is written, "Vengeance is Mine, I will repay," says the Lord. <sup>20</sup>Therefore "If your enemy is hungry, feed him; if he is thirsty, give him a drink; for in so doing you will heap coals of fire on his head." <sup>21</sup>Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good.

# 1. Conflict is a certainty

Rom 12:18 If it is possible, as much as depends on you, live peaceably with all men.

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#### Reasons for conflict:

Rejecting the truth

Rom 1:25 ... who exchanged the truth of God for the lie

Mrk 7:9-12 He said to them, "All too well you reject the commandment of God, that you may keep your tradition. <sup>10</sup> For Moses said, 'Honor your father and your mother'; and, 'He who curses father or mother, let him be put to death.' <sup>11</sup> But you say, 'If a man says to his father or mother, "Whatever profit you might have received from me is Corban"—' (that is, a gift to God), <sup>12</sup> then you no longer let him do anything for his father or his mother,

Pride/self-centeredness

Prov 13:10 By pride comes nothing but strife, ...

Phil 2:3-4 Let nothing be done through selfish ambition or conceit, but in lowliness of mind let each esteem others better than himself. <sup>4</sup> Let each of you look out not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of others.

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 Expecting others to meet needs only God can meet

Phil 4:6-7 Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God;

19 And my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus.

#### 2. Peace is a choice

Rom 12:18 ... as much as depends on you, live peaceably with all men.

Js 3:18 Now the fruit of righteousness is sown in peace by those who make peace.

Js 1:19 So then, my beloved brethren, let every man be swift to hear, slow to speak, slow to wrath; <sup>20</sup>for the wrath of man does not produce the righteousness of God.

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## 3. Revenge is a curse

Rom 12:19 Beloved, do not avenge yourselves, but rather give place to wrath; for it is written [Deut 32:35], "Vengeance is Mine, I will repay," says the Lord.

#### 4. Kindness is a cure

Rom 12:20 Therefore "If your enemy is hungry, feed him; if he is thirsty, give him a drink; for in so doing you will heap coals of fire on his head." [Prov 25:21-22 ...And the Lord will reward you.]

Prov 15:1 A soft answer turns away wrath, but a harsh word stirs up anger.

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# 5. Reconciliation is our calling

- 2 Cor 5:18 [God] has given us the ministry of reconciliation
- Reconciliation is <u>not the same</u> as <u>resolution</u> (reconciliation focuses on the relationship while resolution focuses on the problem)
- Forgiveness is not the same as trust
  (forgiveness is all about the past while trust is all about

Mt 5:9 Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called sons of God.

- He did not say blessed are the peace lovers.
- He did not say blessed are the peaceable.

A peacemaker is one who "attempts" to make peace.

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### What peacemaking is not:

- Avoiding conflict
- Appeasement
- Compromising "core" principles

#### Steps to peacemaking:

- Accept the reality of conflict
- Prefer peace to vindication
- · Pick your hills to die on
- Don't be suckered in to a useless argument
- Learn to hold your silence
- Consider the possibility you might wrong
- Make a real effort to get along

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
