
- His three-year ministry seems all too short.

- His life was never lived in a fevered rush.








1 Cor 4:2 Moreover it is required in stewards that one be found faithful.

There are two ways to use our time:

- We can go through the day responding mainly to the inner compulsions and outward pressures of the moment
- We can make a plan that sets priorities and then prayerfully make decisions in advance

2. We must set God's priorities so urgencies will not dictate our time

Mk 12:30-31 you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength.' This is the first commandment. ³¹ And the second, like it, is this: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.'

Heb 5:12 ... the first principles of the oracles of God;

Js 3:17 But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, willing to yield, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality and without hypocrisy.


Mt 6:33 But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you.

2 Cor 8:5 And not only as we had hoped, but they first gave themselves to the Lord, and then to us by the will of God.
