1. How were Adam and Eve created? What made them special from animals? *They were created in God's image.*
2. What did God tell Adam and Eve to do in the Garden of Eden? *Dress it and care for it.*
3. What special responsibility did God give to Adam that He did not give to anything else He created? *He gave Adam dominion over the earth and the creation.*
4. Why do we also have the responsibility to care for the earth? *We are descendants of Adam. God has commanded it in His Word.*
5. What word describes something that is eternal and will last forever? *Uncorruptible, immortal.*
6. What word means responsibility or rule over something? *Dominion.*
7. Who is the only one in the universe who is uncorruptible? *God.*
8. What word means something that will die one day? *Corruptible, mortal.*
9. We read in Romans about ungodly, foolish men. What had they done? *They had stopped worshipping God and were worshipping other things—man, animals, creeping things.*
10. Some people take their responsibility to care for the earth too seriously. What do they end up worshipping? *The creation.*
11. What is one current issue that a lot of people talk and worry about today? It has to do with the temperature changes on the earth. *Global warming/climate change.*
12. We talked about a promise God made long ago about the earth. Who did God make that promise to? *Noah.*
13. What was that promise? *God is in control. The earth will continue as He created it.*
14. Name one way we can be good stewards of God's creation. *Allow several students to answer. Answers may include pick up trash, care for animals, plant trees and flowers, feed and exercise pets, etc.*
15. What is the verse we are memorizing? *Psalms 8:5–6.*
16. How does the beginning of the memory verse describe man? *A little lower than the angels, crowned with glory and honour.*
