3. What is the first C in the Seven C’s of History? *Creation.*
4. Who committed that very first sin? *Adam and Eve.*
5. Who tempted Eve to sin? *The serpent/Satan.*
6. What did Satan do to trick Eve into disobeying God? What did he change? *God’s Word.*
7. What tree in the garden did God command Adam and Eve not to eat from? *The tree of the knowledge of good and evil.*
8. Adam and Eve tried to cover themselves with fig leaves. It didn’t work. So what did God do? *Killed an animal(s) to make clothes for them.*

10. What did the sin of Adam and Eve bring into the world? *Death.*

17. What kind of a sacrifice was Jesus? *A perfect sacrifice.*
