Eph 2:10 For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.


Workmanship = "poiema": work of art

**Every** believer is uniquely S.H.A.P.E.D for service in God's Kingdom plan.


Every believer will give an account to God for how they use their S.H.A.P.E. to serve in His Kingdom plan.


Your spiritual gift(s) are the primary key to fulfilling the Kingdom Purpose He has set aside just for you.

Rather, awareness that he is a gifted child with an area of ministry should meet every child of God's psychological need to feel wanted and to possess a sense of worth."





## 2. Why are we given a spiritual gift(s)?


1 Cor 12:7 But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to each one for the profit of all:

Jesus said: "the Son of Man came not to be ministered to, but to minister, and to give His life a ransom for many." Mt 20:28










Rom 12:3-6 as God has dealt to each one a measure of faith. <sup>4</sup>For as we have many members in one body, but all the members do not have the same function, <sup>5</sup>so we, being many, are one body in Christ, and individually members of one another. <sup>6</sup>Having then gifts differing according to the grace that is given to us, let us use them:



**1 Cor 12:7,11** But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to each one for the profit of all: ... But one and the same Spirit works all these things, distributing to each one individually as He wills.

Eph 4:11 And He Himself gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers,

**1** Pet 4:10 As each one has received a gift, minister it to one another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God.
