

# Review Questions

1. Which of the Seven C's of History describes how sin entered God's very good creation? *Corruption.*
2. What command or rule did God give Adam and Eve in the Garden of Eden? *Not to eat fruit from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil.*
3. What did God tell Adam and Eve the punishment would be if they disobeyed Him and ate the fruit? *They would die.*
4. What was the first death in the entire universe? *God killed an animal(s) to make clothes for Adam and Eve.*
5. How did Satan disguise himself to tempt Eve in the garden? *As a serpent.*
6. How would the serpent now move about because of God's curse on it? *On its belly!*
7. What would the serpent eat? *Dust of the ground.*
8. What word means that Satan would hate the followers of Jesus? *Enmity.*
9. What was one consequence of sin for the woman? When would she now have lots of pain? *When she had a baby—in childbirth.*
10. How was the ground cursed? What would now grow out of it? *Thorns and thistles.*
11. How would those thorns and thistles in the ground affect Adam? *It would make his work in farming more difficult.*
12. God created Adam from the dust of the earth. As part of the Curse, what would happen to Adam when he died? *He would return to the dust.*
13. Where did God send Adam and Eve? *He drove them out of the garden.*
14. Which attributes of God tell us what He thinks about sin? *He is just. He is holy.*
15. What will God completely remove at the Consummation? *The Curse.*
16. What things will be gone forever in the new heaven and the new earth? (Allow several students to answer.) *Death, crying, sorrow, pain, suffering.*
17. What is the memory verse we started today? *Genesis 6:5.*
18. According to the memory verse, what did God see in the earth? *That the wickedness of man was great, that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually.*
