

# Review Questions

1. Who were the two sons of Adam and Eve we talked about today? *Cain and Abel.*
2. Because this account took place after the Fall, Cain and Abel were born after which C of the Seven C's of History? *Corruption.*
3. What did Cain do for a living? *He was a farmer.*
4. What did Abel do for a living? *He was a shepherd.*
5. What was Cain's offering to the Lord? *Fruit of the land.*
6. What was Abel's offering to the Lord? *An animal from his flock.*
7. Why was Abel's offering accepted by God? *He was righteous and obeyed God.*
8. God did not accept Cain's offering. Why not? *Cain did not love or want to obey God. He was evil.*
9. How did Cain feel about his brother and the sacrifices? *He was jealous of his brother.*
10. What did Cain do to his brother? *He killed his brother.*
11. When Cain killed Abel, this was the very first *what*? It is the name of a sin. *Murder.*
12. God knew what was in Cain's and Abel's hearts. How did God know that? (It is an attribute of God.) *He is omniscient.*
13. Why did God have to punish sin? (It is an attribute of God.) *He is holy and/or just.*
14. What was God's punishment to Cain? *He wouldn't be able to farm; he would be forced to leave home and wander the earth.*
15. How did God show mercy to Cain? *He put a mark on him to protect him from being killed.*
16. What is the meaning of merciful from our Attributes of God Poster? *Kind to those in misery; withholds deserved punishment.*
17. Think about our memory verse. God looked down onto earth. What did he see? *The wickedness of man was great in the earth.*
18. Who can fill in the missing words from the memory verse? *Read the memory verse, pausing before several words to let the student say it: Genesis 6:5 And God saw that the \_\_\_\_\_ (wickedness) of man was great in the earth, and that every \_\_\_\_\_ (imagination) of the thoughts of his heart was only evil \_\_\_\_\_ (continually). Repeat with other students using different missing words, if desired.*
