
Ezk 14:14,20 lists Noah among the three most righteous men in history along with Job and Daniel

1 Chron 1:4 places Noah in the lineage of Abraham

Heb 11:7 By faith Noah, being divinely warned of things not yet seen, moved with godly fear, prepared an ark for the saving of his household, by which he condemned the world and became heir of the righteousness which is according to faith.

The ark was God's design

Gen 6:14-16 Make yourself an ark of gopher wood; make rooms in the ark, and cover it inside and outside with pitch. ¹⁵ And this is how you shall make it: The length of the ark shall be three hundred cubits, its width fifty cubits, and its height thirty cubits. ¹⁶ You shall make a window for the ark, and you shall finish it to a cubit from above; and set the door of the ark in its side. You shall make it with lower, second, and third decks.



Genesis 1-11: Noah's Flood - The 'Ark Of Salvation' - Part 2 (Pastor's Class)








1,400,000 ft³

Approx. 240 sheep can be transported in a boxcar. The ark would have held 125,000 sheep.

The ark is a "type" of God's salvation in Jesus



Gen 6:17-18

Jn 14:6 Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.

The way of salvation for Noah and for us were made by carpenters

The ark was made of cypress wood – gopher wood (incorruptible wood)

Is 53:2 For He shall grow up before Him as a tender plant, and as a root out of dry ground.

John Phillips: "incorruptible wood"

The gates of St. Peter's basilica were made of gopher wood. They lasted for over 1000 yrs without signs of decay.


The ark was "pitched" within and without

Gen 6:14 and cover it inside and outside with pitch.

The word translated "pitch" is the same word translated "atonement"

Hebrew: *kopher*, *kaphar* – to cover




We are not "at one" with God

Rom 8:7 Because the carnal mind is enmity against God; for it is not subject to the law of God, nor indeed can be.

Js 4:4 Adulterers and adulteresses! Do you not know that friendship with the world is enmity with God? Whoever therefore wants to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God.









Is 52:14 Just as many were astonished at you, so His visage was marred more than any man, and His form more than the sons of men;

Is 53:4-12 Yet we esteemed Him stricken, Smitten by God, and afflicted. But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; the chastisement for our peace was upon Him, and by His stripes we are healed. ... And the Lord has laid on Him the iniquity of us all. He was led as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before its shearers is silent, so He opened not His mouth. Yet it pleased the Lord to bruise Him; He has put Him to grief. When You make His soul an offering for sin, My righteous Servant shall justify many, for He shall bear their iniquities. Because He poured out His soul unto death, and He was numbered with the transgressors, and He bore the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors.

Mk 15:38-39 Then the veil of the temple was torn in two from top to bottom. ³⁹ So when the centurion, who stood opposite Him, saw that He cried out like this and breathed His last, he said, "Truly this Man was the Son of God!"

Eph 2:13-16 But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ. ¹⁴ For He Himself is our peace, who has made both one, and has broken down the middle wall of separation, having abolished in His flesh the enmity, that is, the law of commandments contained in ordinances, so as to create in Himself one new man from the two, thus making peace, ¹⁶ and that He might reconcile them both to God in one body through the cross, thereby putting to death the enmity.
