• He falls to the pit


and he cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal on him, so that he should deceive the nations no more till the thousand years were finished. Rev 20:3




He falls to the lake of fire

But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ. 1 Cor 15:57







