POINT 1: Throughout John's Gospel, Jesus has been using earthly terminology to describe spiritual truths and has been misunderstood repeatedly.

- In John 2, Jesus speaks to the Jewish leaders in Jerusalem about "destroying this temple" and in three days He will raise it up. They took Him to be referring to the literal Temple, but He was speaking of His body. (2:19-22).

POINT 1: Throughout John's Gospel, Jesus has been using earthly terminology to describe spiritual truths and has been misunderstood repeatedly.

- In John 3, Jesus told Nicodemus you must be "born again." He said, "You mean I have to get back into my Mother's womb?"

POINT 1: Throughout John's Gospel, Jesus has been using earthly terminology to describe spiritual truths and has been misunderstood repeatedly.

- In John 4, Jesus talks to the Samaritan Woman at Sychar's well about living water. She says "You don't have anything to draw with."

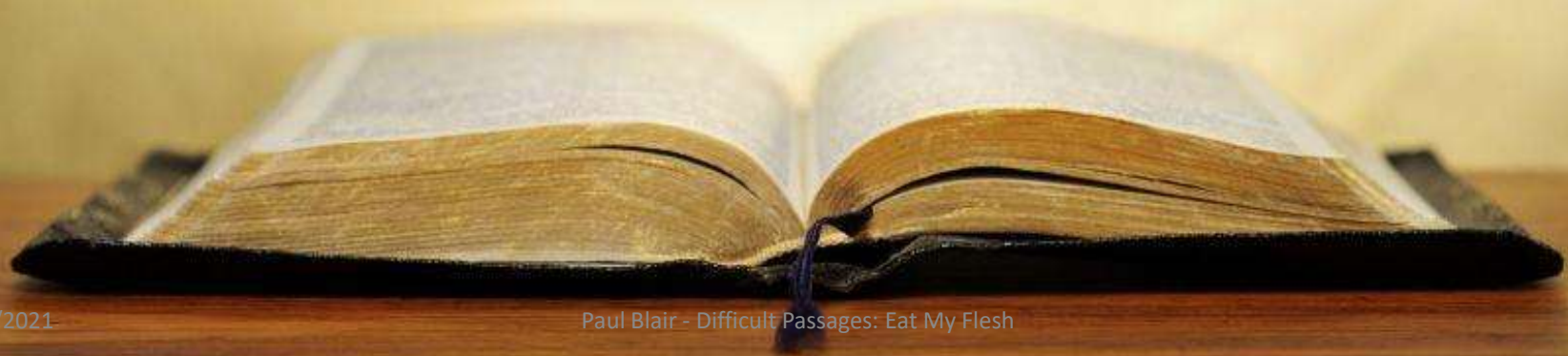
- In John 11, Jesus told the disciple that Lazarus was asleep. They said, "That'll be good for him." Jesus then added, "No, he's dead."

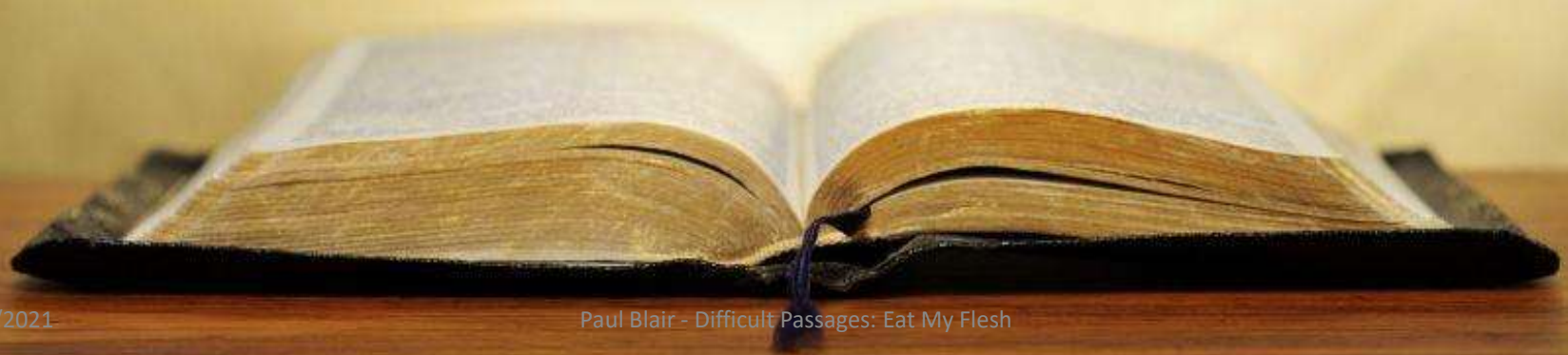

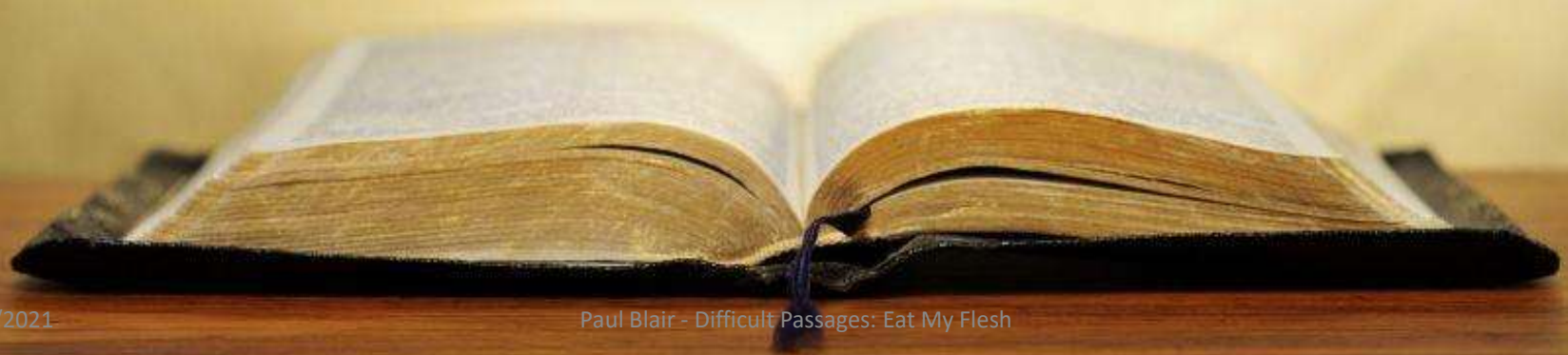

POINT 2: This was specifically listed in the Law and Jesus came to fulfill not destroy the Law.

Lev 17:11-12

POINT 3: This is consistent with other physical illustrations for spiritual truths that John recorded Jesus using throughout this Gospel.

- **In John 7, Jesus claimed to be living water.** But we don't have pitchers of Holy Water in our churches, saying "have a glass or you aren't saved" every Sunday morning.
- **In John 8, Jesus says "I am the light of the world."** But we don't have "Jesus" light bulbs in the sanctuaries claiming salvation when the light's turned on.

POINT 3: This is consistent with other physical illustrations for spiritual truths that John recorded Jesus using throughout this Gospel.

- **In John 10, Jesus said, “I am the good shepherd.”** But we don’t crawl on all four and say “baa” every Sunday morning.
- **In John 10, Jesus says, “I am the door.”** But we don’t have a big door with Jesus above the top and walk through it every Sunday morning.

POINT 3: This is consistent with other physical illustrations for spiritual truths that John recorded Jesus using throughout this Gospel.

- **In John 15, Jesus says, “I am the vine.”** But we don’t hand out pots and potting soil when you arrive.

POINT 1: Throughout John's Gospel, Jesus has been using earthly terminology to describe spiritual truths and has been misunderstood repeatedly.

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Jesus Ministry Year 1



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- **Miracle at Cana.**
- **Attended the first Passover in Jerusalem cleansing the temple accusing them of turning His Father's house into a House of Merchandise.**
- **He had had his private visit with Nicodemus, met the Samaritan woman at Sychar's well and been rejected in his return to Nazareth.**

Jesus Ministry Year 1



- He had moved to Capernaum and preached the Sermon on the Mount.
- He healed the Lame man at the Pool of Bethesda during the Fall feast of Tabernacles.
- He had sent the Twelve out to preach the gospel of the Kingdom only to the lost sheep of the House of Israel. After their return, word reached them that John the Baptist had been killed.

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Jesus Ministry Year 1



- He was tired and wanted some rest. Chapter 6 opens telling us that Passover would soon be coming. (This is a significant note for this incident.)
- There was no place for Jesus to escape. A crowd followed Him and He had compassion on them.

Jesus Ministry

Year 1



- Fed them.
- Placed His disciples on a ship, said He would meet them later and went up to pray alone.
- That night He walked across the Sea of Galilee, rescued his disciples and was at the other side.



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Paul Rely / Birdwatchers: Eat My Flesh

John 6:22-25

22 The day following, when the people which stood on the other side of the sea saw that there was none other boat there, save that one whereinto his disciples were entered, and that Jesus went not with his disciples into the boat, but that his disciples were gone away alone;

24 When the people therefore saw that Jesus was not there, neither his disciples, they also took shipping, and came to Capernaum, seeking for Jesus.

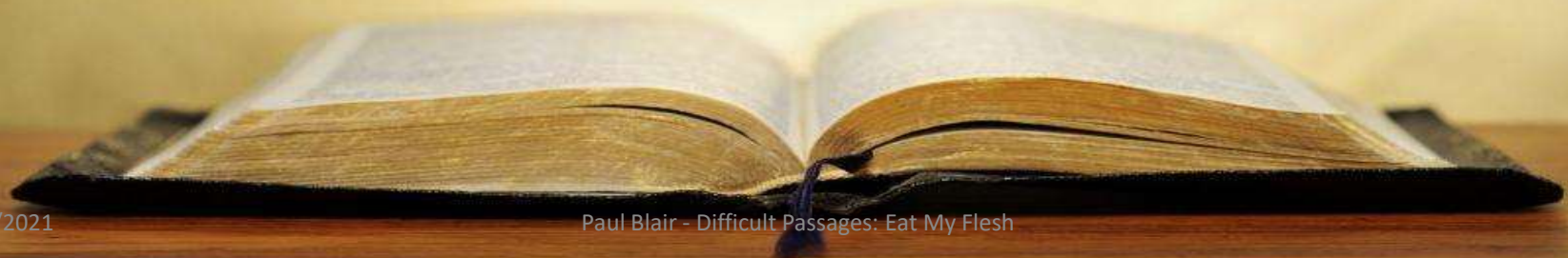

John 6:53-57

Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except ye eat the flesh of the Son of man, and drink his blood, ye have no life in you.

Whoso eateth my flesh, and drinketh my blood, hath eternal life; and I will raise him up at the last day.

For my flesh is meat indeed, and my blood is drink indeed. He that eateth my flesh, and drinketh my blood, dwelleth in me, and I in him.

As the living Father hath sent me, and I live by the Father: so he that eateth me, even he shall live by me.



This is that bread which came down from heaven: not as your fathers did eat manna, and are dead: he that eateth of this bread shall live for ever. These things said he in the synagogue, as he taught in Capernaum.

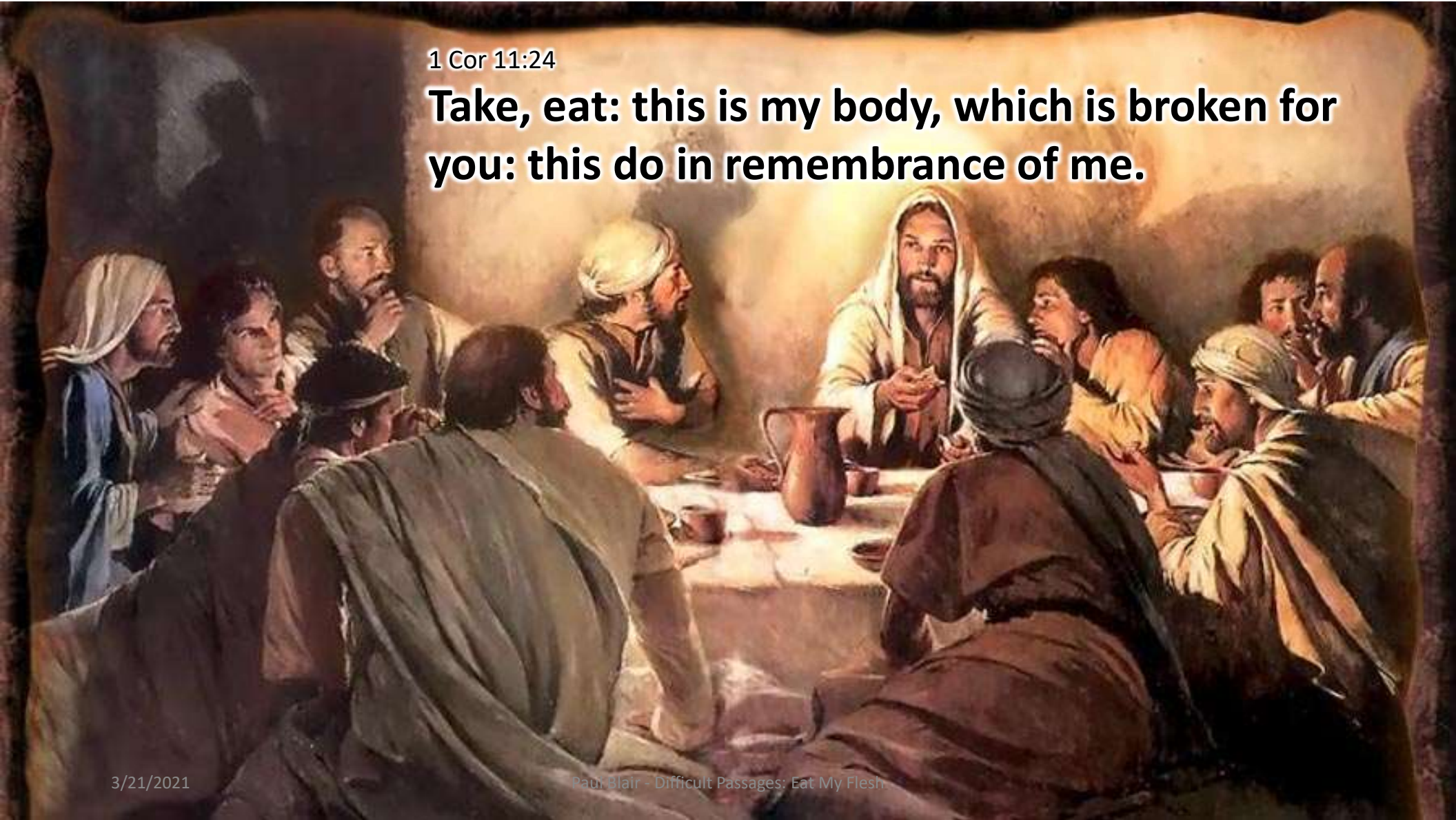
