






Pergamos = evil + marriage



Revelation 2:12 %And to the angel of the church in Pergamos write, #These things says He who has the sharp two-edged sword:

Heb 4:12 For the word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

4. The doctrine of Balaam: compromise (Num 22-25)

If you cand curse them, corrupt them

2 Pet 2:15-16 They have forsaken the right way and gone astray, following the way of Balaam the *son* of Beor, who loved the wages of unrighteousness; ¹⁶but he was rebuked for his iniquity: a dumb donkey speaking with a man¢ voice restrained the madness of the prophet.

5. The doctrine of the Nicolaitans: libertinism or spiritual elitism

- 2 Cor 6:14-17 Do not be unequally yoked together with unbelievers. For what fellowship has righteousness with lawlessness? And what communion has light with darkness? ¹⁵And what accord has Christ with Belial? Or what part has a believer with an unbeliever? ¹⁶And what agreement has the temple of God with idols? For you are the temple of the living God.
- 1 Cor 5:6 Your glorying is not good. Do you not know that a little leaven leavens the whole lump?

Gal 5:13 For you, brethren, have been called to liberty; only do not use liberty as an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another.

1 Pet 2:16 as free, yet not using liberty as a cloak for vice, but as bondservants of God.

6. Their condemnation:

Rev 2:16 Repent, or else I will come to you quickly and will fight against them with the sword of My mouth.

Rom 3:5-6 Is God unjust who inflicts wrath? (I speak as a man.) ⁶Certainly not! For then how will God judge the world?

Rom 1:18 For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who suppress the truth in unrighteousness,

2:5-6 But in accordance with your hardness and your impenitent heart you are treasuring up for yourself wrath in the day of wrath and revelation of the righteous judgment of God, ⁶who will render to each one according to his deeds+:

Rev 6:16-17 and said to the mountains and rocks, ‰all on us and hide us from the face of Him who sits on the throne and from the wrath of the Lamb! ¹⁷For the great day of His wrath has come, and who is able to stand?+
