





Deut 29:20 [Israelites who served other gods] "The Lord would not spare him; for then the anger of the Lord and His jealousy would burn against that man, and every curse that is written in this book would settle on him, and the Lord would blot out his name from under heaven.

1 Sam 15:3 Now go and attack Amalek, and utterly destroy all that they have, and do not spare them. But kill both man and woman, infant and nursing child, ox and sheep, camel and donkey."

5. God did not spare Israel


Is 30:12-14 Therefore thus says the Holy One of Israel: "Because you despise this word, and trust in oppression and perversity, and rely on them, ¹³ Therefore this iniquity shall be to you like a breach ready to fall, a bulge in a high wall, whose breaking comes suddenly, in an instant. ¹⁴ And He shall break it like the breaking of the potter's vessel, which is broken in pieces; He shall not spare. So there shall not be found among its fragments a shard to take fire from the hearth, or to take water from the cistern."

Jer 13:14 And I will dash them one against another, even the fathers and the sons together," says the Lord. "I will not pity nor spare nor have mercy, but will destroy them."


Ezk 5:11; 7:4,9; 8:18; 9:5,10; 24:14 My eye will not spare, nor will I have any pity. ... I will repay you according to your ways, ... Therefore I also will act in fury. My eye will not spare nor will I have pity; and though they cry in My ears with a loud voice, I will not hear them." ... I will not hold back, nor will I spare, nor will I relent;

Rom 11:21 For if God did not spare the natural branches, ...

11:21-22 He may not spare you either. ²² Therefore consider the goodness and severity of God: on those who fell, severity; but toward you, goodness, if you continue in His goodness. Otherwise you also will be cut off.









Heb 10:28-31 Anyone who has rejected Moses' law dies without mercy on the testimony of two or three witnesses. ²⁹ Of how much worse punishment, do you suppose, will he be thought worthy who has trampled the Son of God underfoot, counted the blood of the covenant by which he was sanctified a common thing, and insulted the Spirit of grace? ³⁰ For we know Him who said, "Vengeance is Mine, I will repay," says the Lord. Neh 13:22 [warning Israelites who profaned the Sabbath] Remember me, O my God, concerning this also, and spare me according to the greatness of Your mercy!
