The word “spare” occurs some 42 times in Scripture and the vast majority of its use refers to God not sparing sinners.



God is a God of unending love, and He extends His love to all.

1 Jn 4:8 ... for God is love

1 Jn 4:16 And we have known and believed the love that God has for us. God is love, and he who abides in love abides in God, and God in him.

Eph 3:19 to know the love of Christ which passes knowledge ...


Jn 3:16-17 For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life. ¹⁷ For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved.

God is a God of unbending justice, and He imposes His justice on all.

Nahum 1:3 The Lord is slow to anger and great in power, and will not at all acquit the wicked.

Ex 34:6-7 “The Lord, the Lord God, merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abounding in goodness and truth, ⁷ keeping mercy for thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin, by no means clearing the guilty, ...

Jn 3:18-19 “He who believes in Him is not condemned; but he who does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God. ¹⁹ And this is the condemnation, that the light has come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil.



Mt 7:13-14 “Enter by the narrow gate; for wide is the gate and broad is the way that leads to destruction, and there are many who go in by it. ¹⁴ Because narrow is the gate and difficult [confined] is the way which leads to life, and there are few who find it.

Mt 7:21-23 “Not everyone who says to Me, ‘Lord, Lord,’ shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in heaven. ²² Many will say to Me in that day, ‘Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Your name, cast out demons in Your name, and done many wonders in Your name?’ ²³ And then I will declare to them, ‘I never knew you; depart from Me, you who practice lawlessness!’

Mt 13:49-50 So it will be at the end of the age. The angels will come forth, separate the wicked from among the just, ⁵⁰ and cast them into the furnace of fire. There will be wailing and gnashing of teeth.”



1. God did not spare the sinning angels

2 Pet 2:4 For if God did not spare the angels who sinned, but cast them down to hell [Tartarus] and delivered them into chains of darkness, to be reserved for judgment;



2. God did not spare the sinners of Noah's day

2 Pet 2:5 and did not spare the ancient world, but saved Noah, one of eight people, a preacher of righteousness, bringing in the flood on the world of the ungodly;



3. God did not spare Sodom and Gomorrah

2 Pet 2:6 and turning the cities of Sodom and Gomorrah into ashes, condemned them to destruction, making them an example to those who afterward would live ungodly;

4. God will not spare any of the wicked

Ps 78:50 [Egyptians] He made a path for His anger; He did not spare their soul from death, but gave their life over to the plague,


Deut 29:20 [Israelites who served other gods] “The Lord would not spare him; for then the anger of the Lord and His jealousy would burn against that man, and every curse that is written in this book would settle on him, and the Lord would blot out his name from under heaven.

1 Sam 15:3 Now go and attack Amalek, and utterly destroy all that they have, and do not spare them. But kill both man and woman, infant and nursing child, ox and sheep, camel and donkey.”

5. God did not spare Israel

Is 30:12-14 Therefore thus says the Holy One of Israel: “Because you despise this word, and trust in oppression and perversity, and rely on them, ¹³ Therefore this iniquity shall be to you like a breach ready to fall, a bulge in a high wall, whose breaking comes suddenly, in an instant. ¹⁴ And He shall break it like the breaking of the potter’s vessel, which is broken in pieces; **He shall not spare**. So there shall not be found among its fragments a shard to take fire from the hearth, or to take water from the cistern.”

Jer 13:14 And I will dash them one against another, even the fathers and the sons together,” says the Lord. “**I will not pity nor spare nor have mercy**, but will destroy them.”



Ezk 5:11; 7:4,9; 8:18; 9:5,10; 24:14 My eye will not spare, nor will I have any pity. ... I will repay you according to your ways, ... Therefore I also will act in fury. My eye will not spare nor will I have pity; and though they cry in My ears with a loud voice, I will not hear them.” ... I will not hold back, nor will I spare, nor will I relent;

Rom 11:21 For if God did not spare the natural branches, ...

11:21-22 He may not spare you either. ²² Therefore consider the goodness and severity of God: on those who fell, severity; but toward you, goodness, if you continue in His goodness. Otherwise you also will be cut off.




6. God did not spare His own son

Rom 8:32 He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, ...

If there had ever been a time when God would have leaned away from justice and toward leniency, it would have been when all of our sins were laid on Jesus. But He did not spare Jesus.

7. So, God will not spare those who reject His Son

Heb 10:28-31 Anyone who has rejected Moses' law dies without mercy on the testimony of two or three witnesses. ²⁹ Of how much worse punishment, do you suppose, will he be thought worthy who has trampled the Son of God underfoot, counted the blood of the covenant by which he was sanctified a common thing, and insulted the Spirit of grace? ³⁰ For we know Him who said, "Vengeance is Mine, I will repay," says the Lord. And again, "The Lord will judge His people." ³¹ It is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God.


8. God will spare everyone who seeks redemption

Neh 13:22 [warning Israelites who profaned the Sabbath] Remember me, O my God, concerning this also, and spare me according to the greatness of Your mercy!


