Legs of Iron - Rome

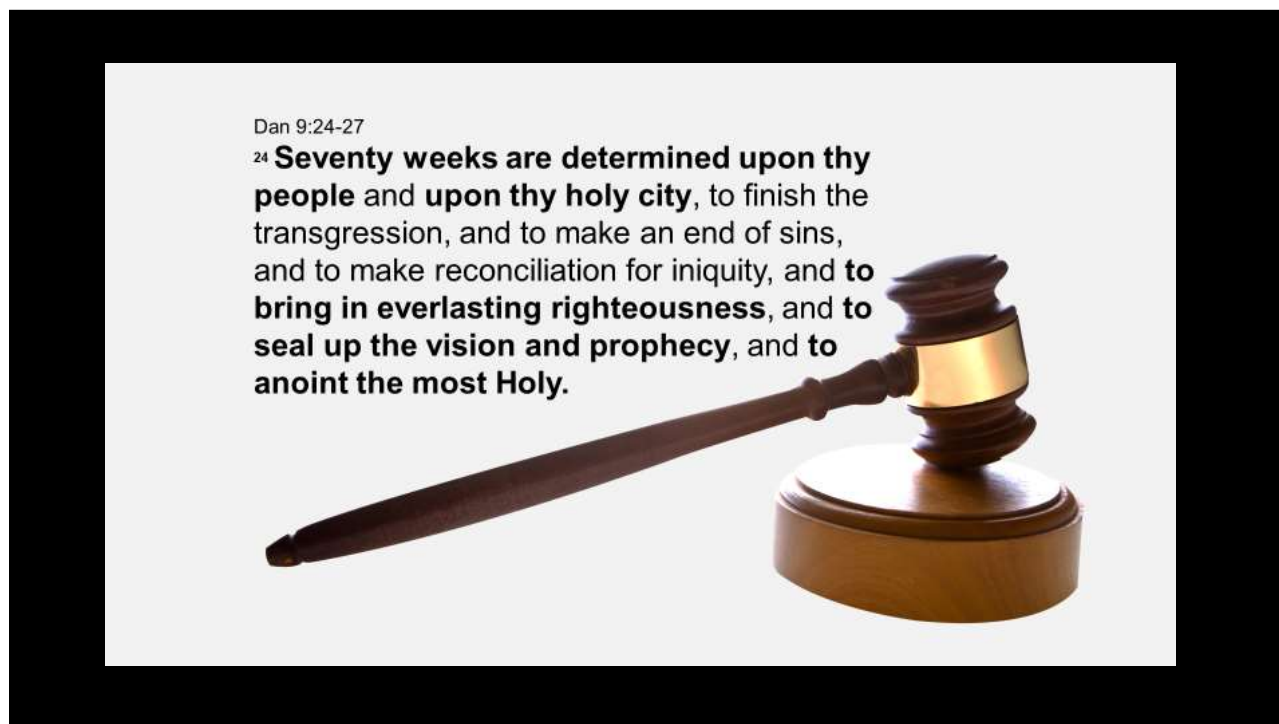
Rev 17:10 And there are seven kings: five are fallen, and one is (Rome), and the other is not yet come; and when he cometh, he must continue a short space.
