

## Hebrews 11:28-40

**28** Through faith he kept the passover, and the sprinkling of blood, lest he that destroyed the firstborn should touch them.

**29** By faith they passed through the Red sea as by dry land: which the Egyptians assaying to do were drowned.

**30** By faith the walls of Jericho fell down, after they were compassed about seven days.

**31** By faith the harlot Rahab perished not with them that believed not, when she had received the spies with peace.

**32** And what shall I more say? for the time would fail me to tell of Gedeon, and of Barak, and of Samson, and of Jephthae; of David also, and Samuel, and of the prophets:

**33** Who through faith subdued kingdoms, wrought righteousness, obtained promises, stopped the mouths of lions,

**34** Quenched the violence of fire, escaped the edge of the sword, out of weakness were made strong, waxed valiant in fight, turned to flight the armies of the aliens.

**35** Women received their dead raised to life again: and others were tortured, not accepting deliverance; that they might obtain a better resurrection:

**36** And others had trial of cruel mockings and scourgings, yea, moreover of bonds and imprisonment:

**37** They were stoned, they were sawn asunder, were tempted, were slain with the sword: they wandered about in sheepskins and goatskins; being destitute, afflicted, tormented;

**38** (Of whom the world was not worthy:) they wandered in deserts, and in mountains, and in dens and caves of the earth.

**39** And these all, having obtained a good report through faith, received not the promise:

**40** God having provided some better thing for us, that they without us should not be made perfect.

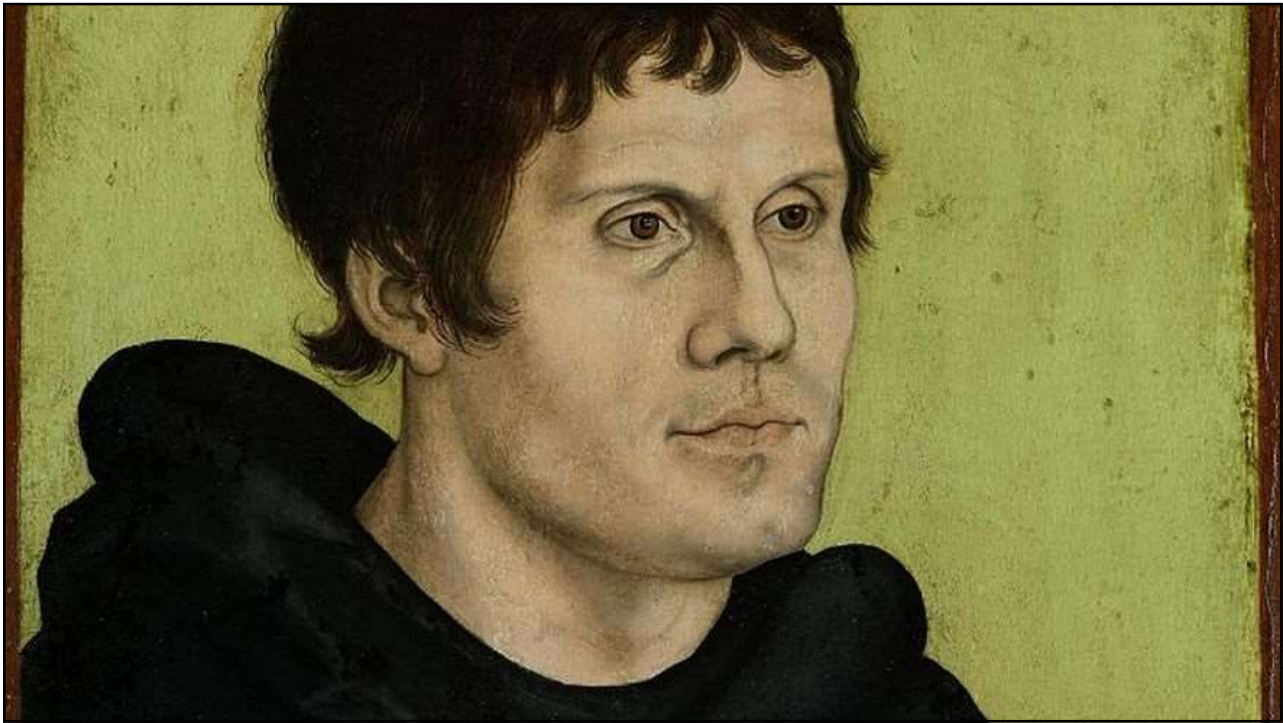
Constantine the Great's Vision of the Cross by Raphael
