





1 Cor 9:24 Do you not know that those who run in a race all run, but one receives the prize? Run in such a way that you may obtain it.


1 Cor 6:12 All things are lawful for me, but all things are not helpful. All things are lawful for me, but I will not be brought under the power of any.






1 Cor 7:29 But this I say, brethren, the time is short, ...

Rom 13:11-14 And do this, knowing the time, that now it is high time to awake out of sleep; for now our salvation is nearer than when we first believed. ¹² The night is far spent, the day is at hand. Therefore let us cast off the works of darkness, and let us put on the armor of light. ¹³ Let us walk properly, as in the day, not in revelry and drunkenness, not in lewdness and lust, not in strife and envy. ¹⁴ But put on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make no provision for the flesh, to fulfill its lusts.

Jn 16:33 In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world."


2 Tim 3:12 Yes, and all who desire to live godly in Christ Jesus will suffer persecution.


Jn 14:3 I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also.
