Henderson Hills Mission—1964

In December 1959, Mr. and Mrs. C. A. Henderson, developers of the Henderson Hill Addition to Edmond, gave the church four acres of land for a Baptist church building just south of the addition. In 1962, the church voted to invest \$100,000 in the building and to hire an architect to draw up plans. The church was opened for services on May 3, 1964. The

Rev. Eugene Stockwell served as interim pastor of the mission church from March 4, 1964, to July 18, 1965, when James H. Wright was called to pastor the new church. Dr. Ramay presided over the meeting when the mission was organized into a church on March 20, 1966. Charter members requesting letters from First Baptist Church numbered 243.



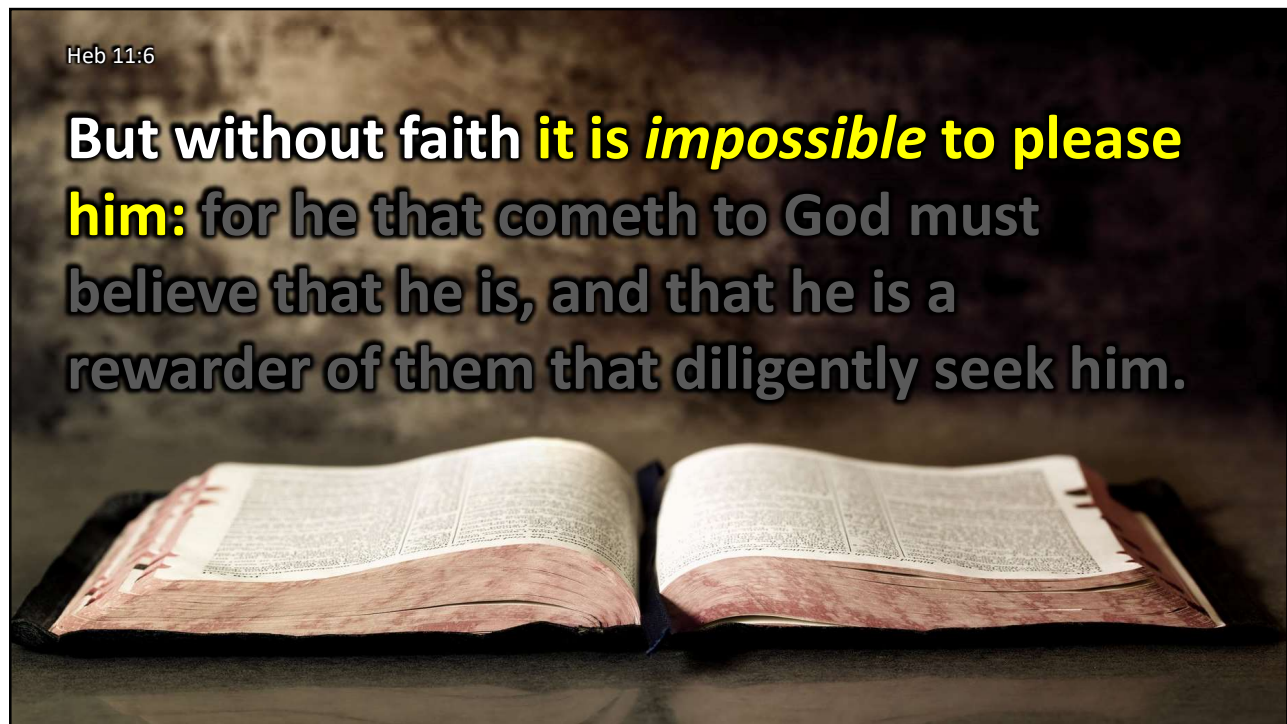
