





Cruz: "Under the modern, leftist sensibilities, if I decide right now that I am a woman, then, apparently, I am a woman. Does that mean I would have Article III standing to challenge a genderbased restriction? If I can change my gender and be a woman and an hour later if I decide I am not a woman anymore, I guess I would lose Article III standing," Cruz said. "Does that same principle apply to other protected characteristics? For example, I'm a Hispanic man. Could I decide I was an Asian man? Would I have the ability to be an Asian man and challenge Harvard's discrimination because I made that decision?"







What is reason?

"The ability to recognize truth/fact and to be able to use that truth to offer a factual defense; the power of the mind to think, understand, and form judgments by understanding that which is true."














Rom 1:24 changed the glory of the incorruptible God into an image made like corruptible man – and birds and four-footed animals and creeping things.



They change truth into something ٠ deceptive

Rom 1:25 who exchanged the truth of God for the lie, and worshiped and served the creature rather than the Creator, who is blessed forever. Amen.



• They change sex into something degenerate (Lk 17:28-30)

Rom 1:26-27 For this reason God gave them up to vile passions. For even their women exchanged the natural use for what is against nature. ²⁷ Likewise also the men, leaving the natural use of the woman, burned in their lust for one another, men with men committing what is shameful, and receiving in themselves the penalty of their error which was due.




• They change sin into something desirable

Rom 1:28-32 And even as they did not like to retain God in their knowledge, God gave them over to a depraved mind, to do those things which are not 29 fitting; being filled with all sexual unrighteousness, immorality, wickedness, covetousness, maliciousne ss; full of envy, murder, strife, deceit, evil-mindedness; they are whisperers,




³⁰ backbiters, haters of God, violent, proud, boasters, inventors of evil things, disobedient to parents, ³¹ undiscerning, untrustworthy, unloving, unforgiving, unmerciful; ³² who, knowing the righteous judgment of God, that those who practice such things are deserving of death, not only do the same but also approve of those who practice them.



Depraved mind: tested and found useless, disqualified for its intended purpose; a nonfunctioning mind where the conscience cannot function

Prov 1:22-30 "How long, you simple ones, will you love simplicity? For scorners delight in their scorning, and fools hate knowledge. ²³ Turn at my rebuke; surely I will pour out my spirit on you; I will make my words known to you. ²⁴ Because I have called and you refused, I have stretched out my hand and no one regarded, ²⁵ Because you disdained all my counsel, and would have none of my rebuke, ²⁶ I also will laugh at your calamity; I will mock when your terror comes,



When your terror comes like a 27 storm, and your destruction comes like whirlwind, when distress a and anguish come upon you. ²⁸ "Then they will call on me, but I will not answer; they will seek me diligently, but they will not find me. ²⁹ Because they hated knowledge and did not choose the fear of the Lord, ³⁰ They would have none of my counsel and despised my every rebuke.

2 Tim 3:1-9,13 But know this, that in the last days perilous times will come: ² For men will be lovers of themselves, lovers of money, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient unthankful. to parents, unholy, 3 unloving, unforgiving, slanderers, without self-control, brutal, despisers of good, ⁴ traitors, headstrong, haughty, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God, ⁵ having a form of godliness denying but its power. ⁶ For of this sort are those who creep into households and make captives of gullible women loaded down with sins, led away by various lusts, ⁷ always learning and never able to come to the knowledge of the truth. ⁸ Now as Jannes and Jambres resisted Moses, so do these also resist the truth: men of corrupt minds, disapproved concerning the faith; ⁹ but they will progress no further, for their folly will be manifest to all, as theirs also was. ... ¹³ But evil men and impostors will grow worse and worse, deceiving and being deceived.
