







The Financial Times Lexicon defines ESG as "a generic term used in capital markets and used by investors to evaluate corporate behavior and to determine the future financial performance of companies. ESG is a subset of non-financial performance indicators which include sustainable, ethical and corporate governance issues such as managing a company's carbon footprint and ensuring there are systems in place to ensure accountability. They are factors in investment considerations, used in risk assessment strategies incorporated into both investment decisions and risk management processes."

"Environmental, social, and governance (ESG) metrics are a kind of social credit system designed to coerce businesses—and, by extension, individuals and all of society to transform their practices.

carrot-and-stick Through a approach, investors (and and banks soon governments) use ESG to push businesses to change how they function, regardless of what the employees and customers of those businesses want. In many cases, however, corporate executives are all too willing to go along, because they want access to the cheap capital offered by investors and financial institutions.

The widespread adoption of ESG metrics, which is also commonly called 'stakeholder capitalism'—is meant to *radically alter* how businesses are evaluated, expanding considerations beyond traditional economic metrics like profit, revenue, debt, customer satisfaction, and product development.

Instead of looking at economic and financial considerations, ESG social credit metrics measure things like, 'Percentage of active workforce covered under collective bargaining agreements' (union labor), and 'Percentage of employees per employee category, by age group, gender and other indicators of diversity (e.g. ethnicity).""









Ultimately, measuring social impact, particularly in a consistent way across companies and sectors and in a manner that can be audited, is much more difficult than, let's say, measuring the size of one's carbon footprint or one's diversity and inclusion metrics. ... we want companies to be as incentivized to do social impact work as they are to do environmental work.

- Corporate Knights Global 100: an annual global ranking of corporate sustainability performance by Toronto-based magazine Corporate Knights
- Sustainalytics ESG Risk Ratings: designed to help investors identify financially material ESG risks for more than 12,000 companies
- Dow Jones Sustainability Index Family: headlined by DJSI World, which represents the top 10% most sustainable companies among the largest 2,500 in the S&P Global BMI
- Thomson Reuters ESG Scores: measures ESG performance across 10 themes for more than 6,000 companies globally



Heb 13:4 Marriage is honorable among all, and the bed undefiled; but fornicators and adulterers God will judge.


Ex 20:14 You shall not commit adultery

Rom 1:26-27 For this reason God gave them up to vile passions. For even their women exchanged the natural use for what is against nature. ²⁷ Likewise also the men, leaving the natural use of the woman, burned in their lust for one another, men with men committing what is shameful, and receiving in themselves the penalty of their error which was due.

1 Cor 6:9-11 Do you not know that the unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived. Neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor homosexuals, nor sodomites, ¹⁰ nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners will inherit the kingdom of God. ¹¹ And such were some of you. Rom 13:1-5 Let every soul be subject to the governing authorities. For there is no authority except from God, and the authorities that exist are appointed by God. ² Therefore whoever resists the authority resists the ordinance of God, and those who resist will bring judgment on themselves. ³ For rulers are not a terror to good works, but to evil. Do you want to be unafraid of the authority? Do what is good, and you will have praise from the same. ⁴ For he is God's minister to you for good. But if you do evil, be afraid; for he does not bear the sword in vain; for he is God's minister, an avenger to execute wrath on him who practices evil. ⁵ Therefore you must be subject, not only because of wrath but also for conscience' sake.

Rom 12:18 If it is possible, as much as depends on you, live peaceably with all men.

Acts 5:29 But Peter and the other apostles answered and said: "We ought to obey God rather than men.
