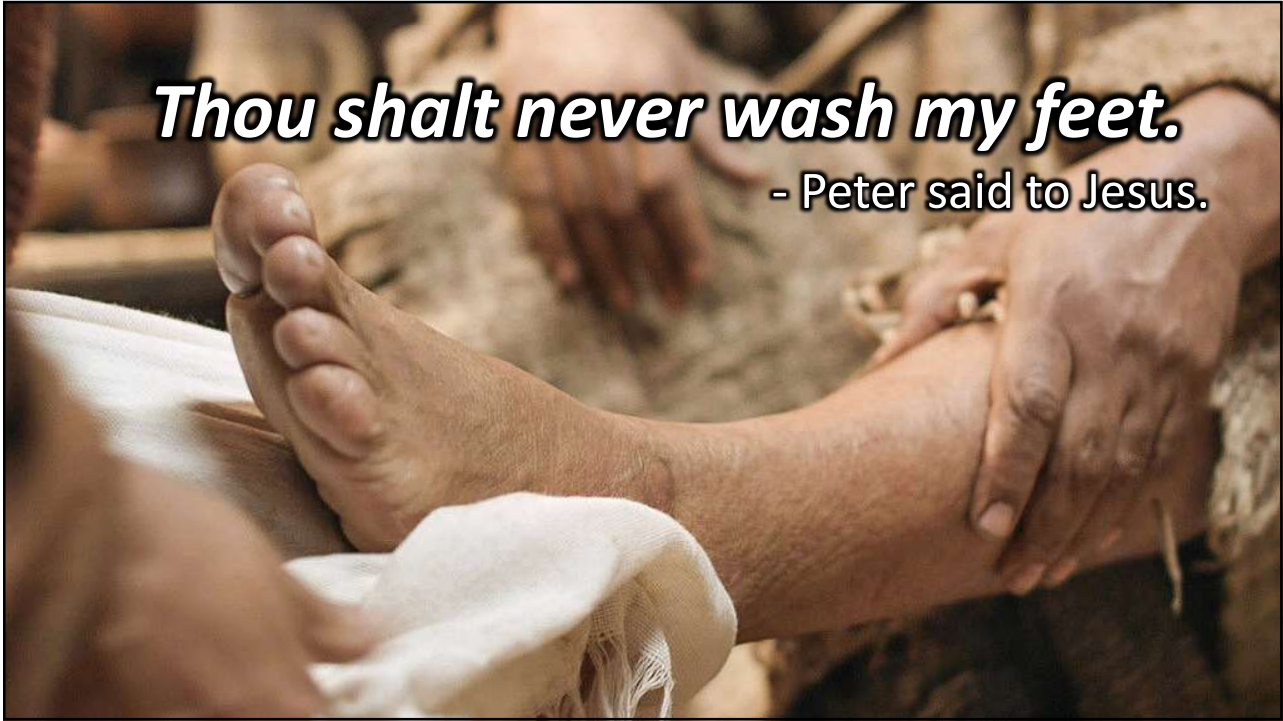

³⁵ By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples, if ye have love one to another.



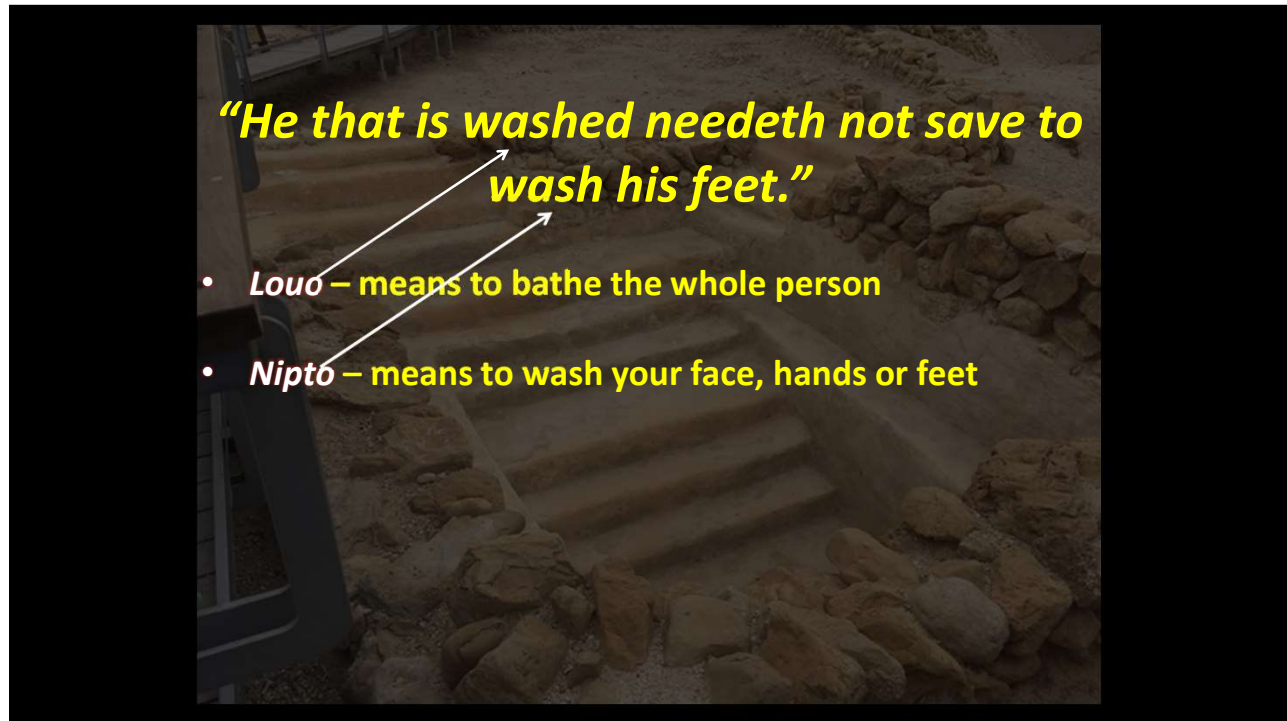

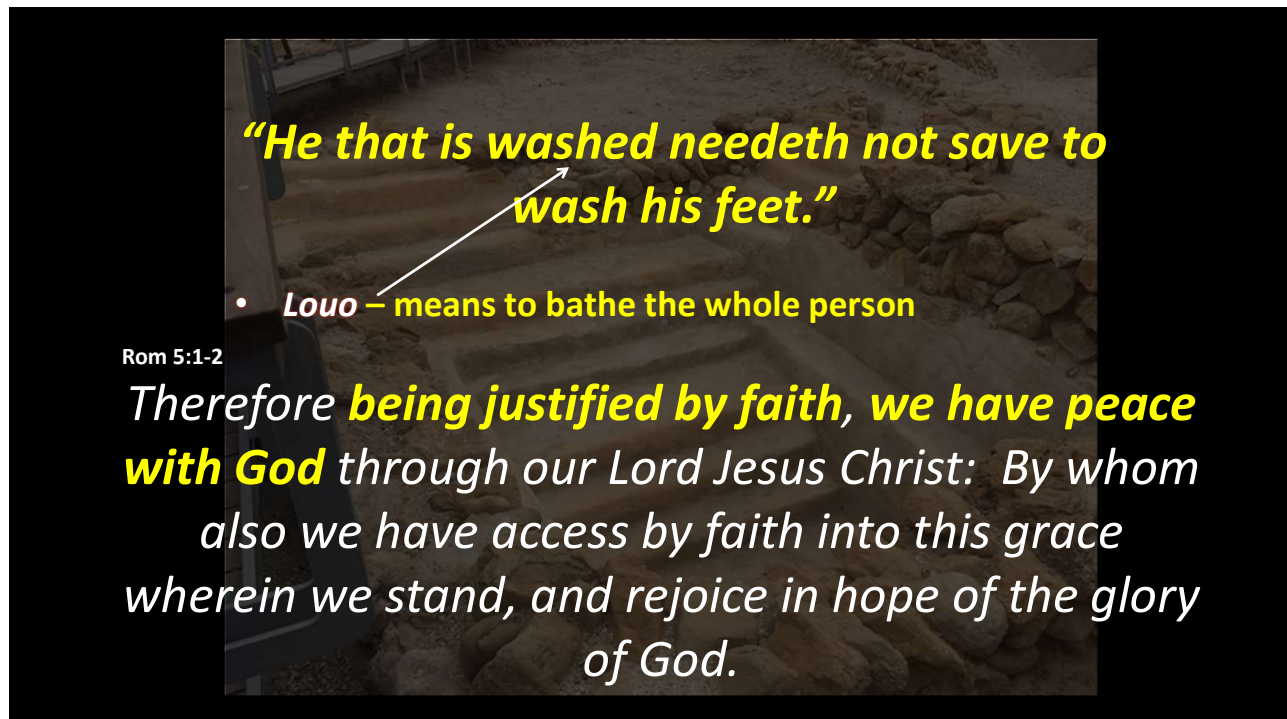



- ***Nipto*** – means to wash your face, hands or feet

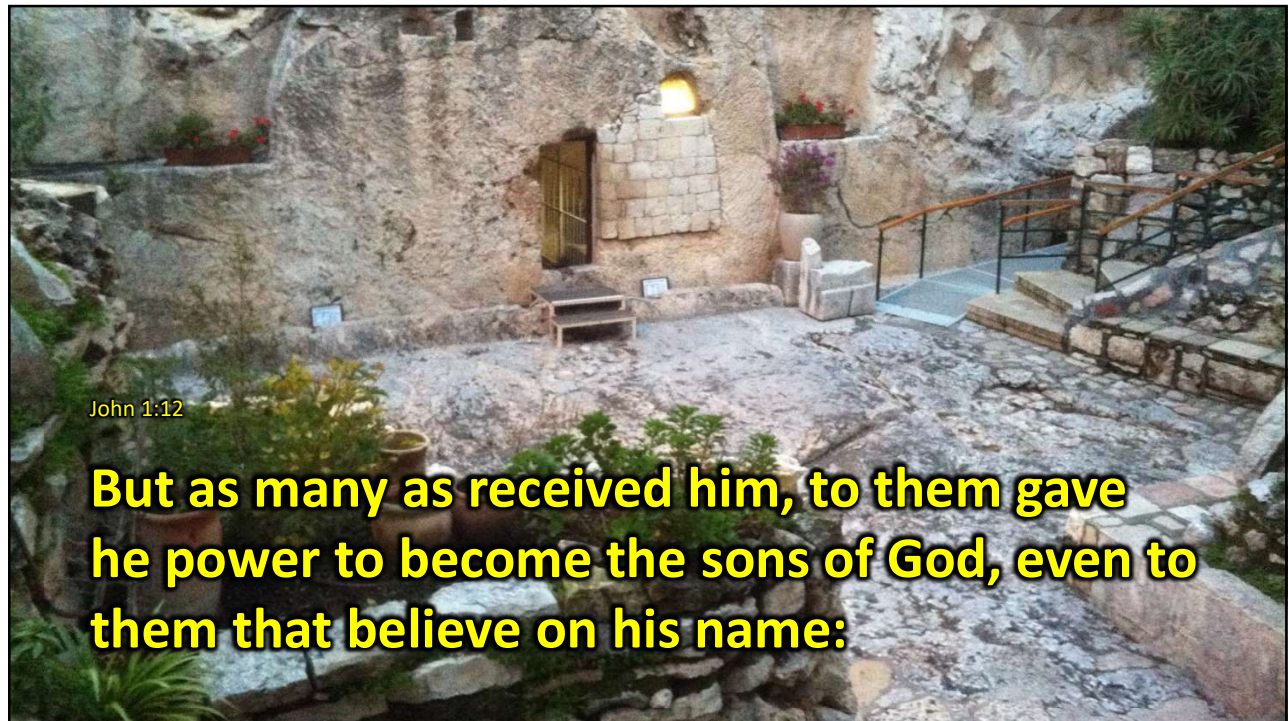

For you will be treated as you treat others. The standard you use in judging is the standard by which you will be judged.

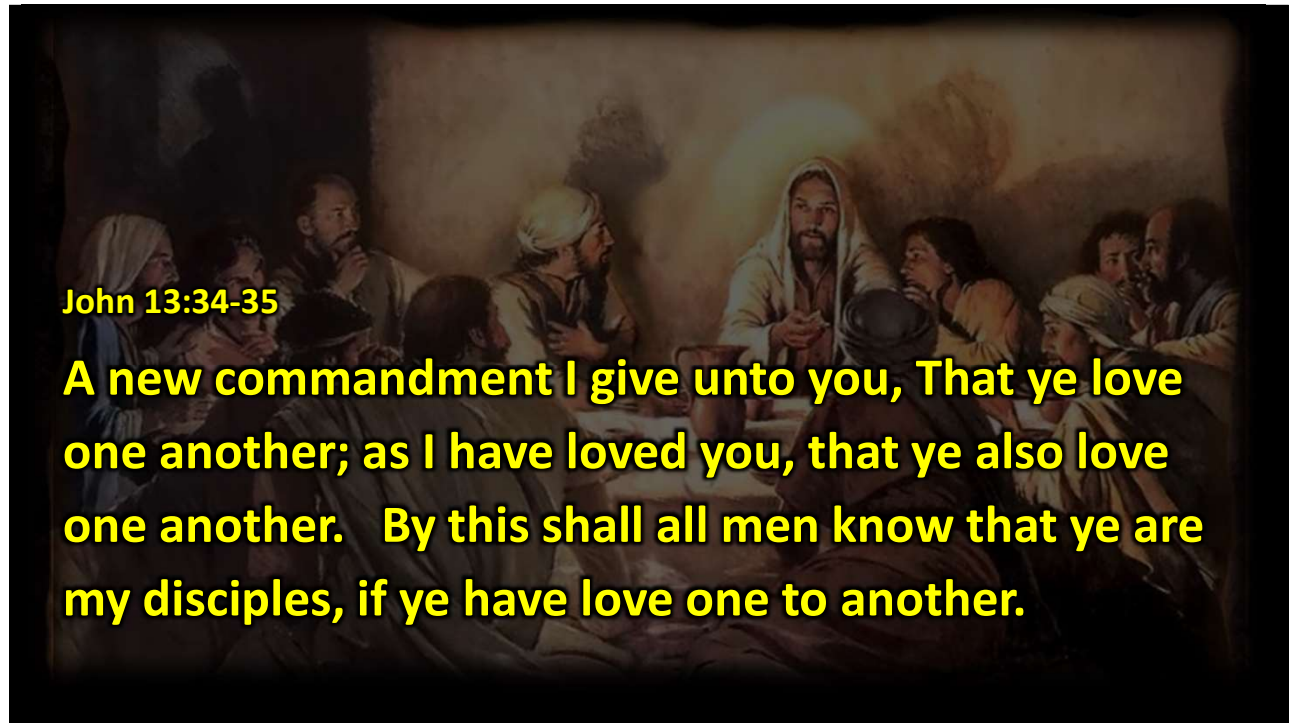

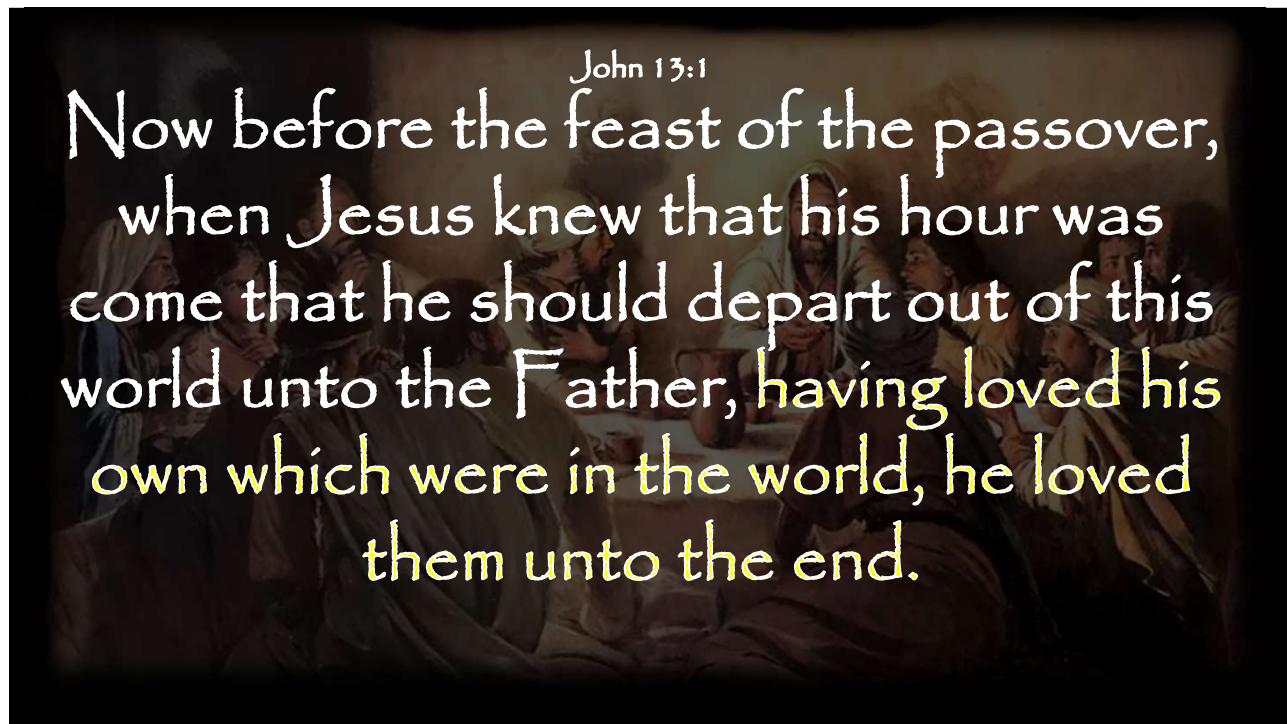

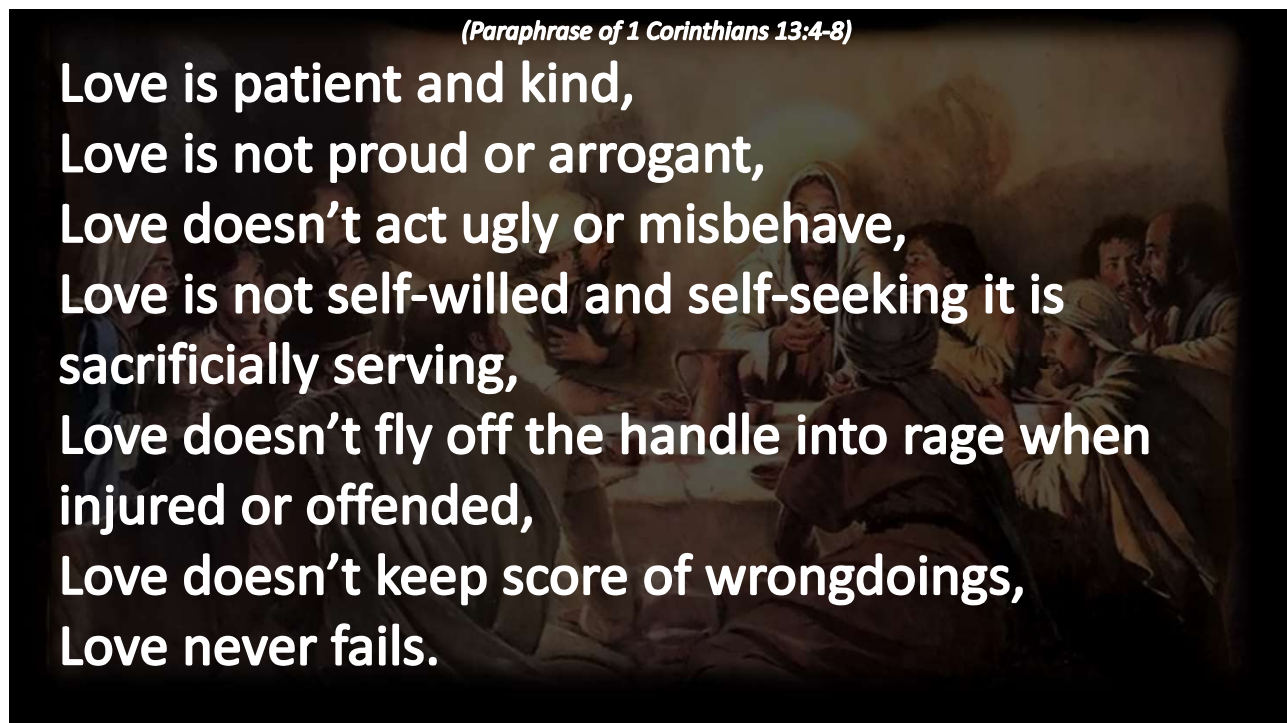
