
## LOVING OTHERS...

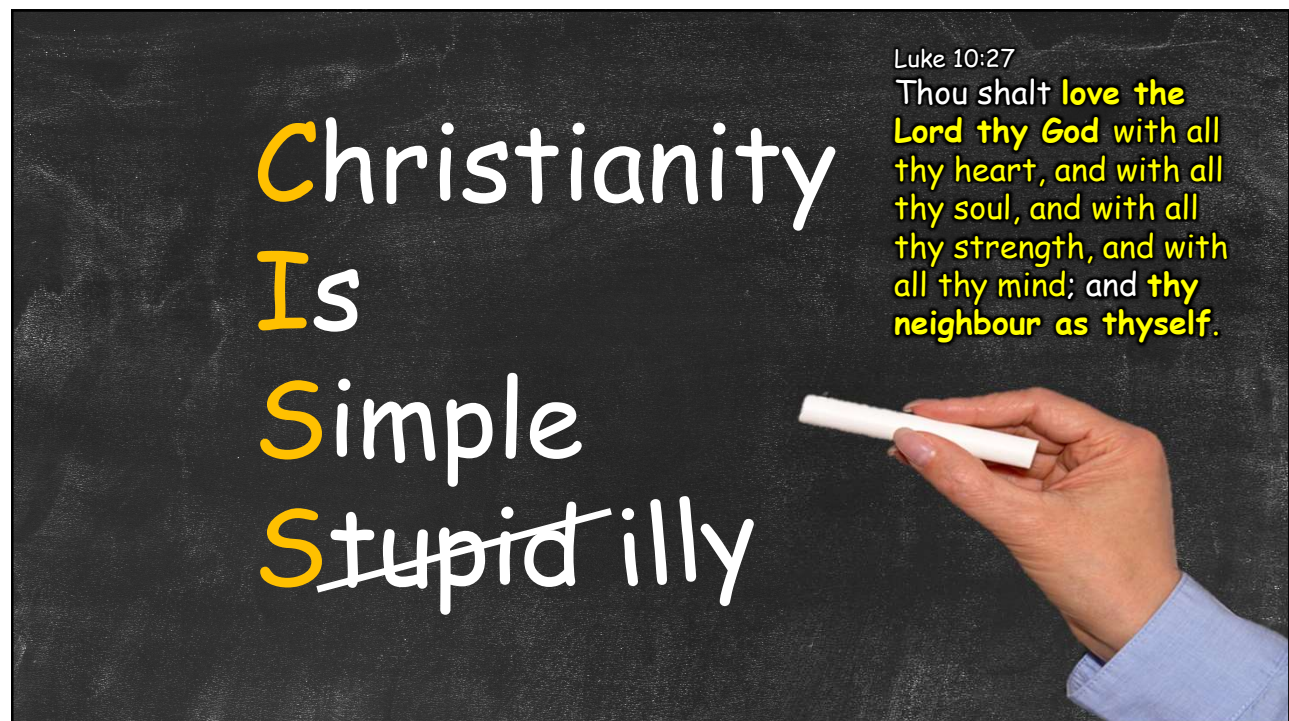
