



1) Liberty Church

We have been working for ten years in an attempt to awaken pastors. The modern pastor has been taught in seminary to be the CEO of an organization designed to attract numbers rather than being God's prophetic voice and transforming lives. Most pastors have been taught to avoid controversy while delivering their seminary approved "three points and a story" messages.

We have discovered most pastors who will not engage on important issues are afraid of:

- 1) Their Board of Elders/Deacons
- 2) Losing numbers in their congregations and money in offerings

 3) Being criticized as a homophobe, Islamophobe or being labeled as intolerant.
- 4) Losing their jobs

As Barna's study recently concluded, most pastors are aware that the IRS cannot take away tax exemptions and most pastors are aware that issues such as abortion. homosexual marriage and the national debt are addressed in the Bible. As I travel the country, I am continually asked, "Is there a church like yours around here?" or "Is there a pastor around here that preaches like you do?"

The Solution

At one time, circuit riding preachers made their rounds by horseback. That was the technology of the day. Now, we must use the technology of our day

I propose four "Liberty Church" facilities. Each facility would need at minimum to start a campus pastor, secretary, music ministry, youth ministry, nursery, and A/V tech. Only the secretary and pastor would need be full time paid positions, initially. Each facility would have their own music, announcements and onsite invitation. The sermon would be live streamed on a state of the art HD screen and amplification. My time will be split between Oklahoma City and Orlando. As we add Nashville and Boston, I will spend several weeks in each establishing the new church. Then, would speak in each location at least once quarterly, while devoting most of my time to Oklahoma City and Orlando. Each church would need state of the art A/V systems, startup salaries for staff for one year and sufficient funds for bills, radio and advertising for one year

2) Black Robed Regiment Boot Camps

We must find motivated pastors – either through pressure from their members OR they are self-motivated.

Host 3 or 4 regional meetings. Perhaps one per week for a month. Then, ask these graduates to recommend one pastor each. We can schedule pastor's boot camps twice per year or once per quarter. Whatever we can afford based upon funding.

3) Local Online Newspapers

In 2006, I attended the Reclaiming America for Christ Conference in Coral Ridge, FL. One speaker was the attorney David Gibbs, Jr. David was the attorney for the family of Terry Shiyo. What he shared with the audience was not even close to the story presented by the mass media. The media holds considerable control over the populace and they control the flow of information and what truth claims are presented.

I have noticed, also, that even in a conservative area like Oklahoma City, the Editors are terribly leftist. Fortunately, in this day of technology, we no longer need multimillion dollar presses and distribution systems. Even though I still subscribe to the paper, I enjoy the online version and prefer it.

Why don't we establish local online papers with OBJECTIVE conservative editors who can assure an honest presentation of the facts? No presses, no paper routes, just an online version for subscribers.

We could establish a complete online paper that focuses on news, weather and sports. Leave the special interest stories to the individual community papers.

- Local News: One news editor and a number of reporters dependent upon the size of the city to cover real news.
- Weather: Utilize the local office of the National Weather Service. Most people
 are only interested in the forecast for the day and the next week.
- Sports: (Optional) However, with a decent sports page, we could eliminate the need for any subscription to the local "Daily" paper.

4) Reclaiming America for Christ Radio Network

Jesus promised the "gates of hell" would not be able to stand against His church. What we fail to remember is that the "gates" of a city were its defenses. Unfortunately, the church has largely failed to go on the offensive and pierce the devil's strongholds.

The typical radio ministry feeds the existing flock by reaching areas with strong listener support. Our plan is to literally invade the devil's strongholds. Boston, Washington, DC, New York, Philadelphia, Chicago Detroit, Los Angeles, Cleveland, Cincinnati, Orlando and Miami are a sampling of cities we would like to reach into. 5) Restoring Federalism

America is not designed for 318 million people to be ruled by one centralized power in Washington, DC.
