
- OT:



Consistent Message: The Messiah...


- ...born of a virgin and He was.

- ...that He would rise from the dead and see his seed and prolong his days ascending to the right hand of the Father and He did.









Muhammed claimed to be the last prophet – Moses, Jesus and him.
 The Koran was not written by Muhammad. He was illiterate. The Koran was a collection of his stories and prophecies as was remembered and recorded by his followers.
 Unlike the Bible, the Koran is not arranged chronologically. The chapters or Suras were simply compiled by length from longest to shortest.





Islam rejects the Deity of Christ:

- Sura 5:75: "Christ, the son of Mary, was no more than a messenger; many were the messengers that passed away before him."
- Sura 9:30: "...the Christians call "Christ the Son of God." That is a saying from their mouth; (In this) they but imitate what the Unbelievers of the old used to say. Allah's curse be on them: how they are deluded from the truth."
- Sura 5:17: Infidels are those who declare: God is the Christ, the son of Mary.
- Sura 5:73: Infidels are those that say "God is one of three in a Trinity.

- Col 2:9 For in him dwelleth all the fulness of the Godhead bodily.
- **Isa 7:14** Therefore the Lord himself shall give you a sign; Behold, a virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel.




- Rom 5:8 But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.







- 1. Worship Allah alone and accept Muhammad as Allah's prophet and believe in the Koran.


