


Ezekiel compares Daniel with Noah & Job

Ezk 14:14 Even if these three men, Noah, Daniel, and Job, were in it, they would deliver only themselves by their righteousness," says the Lord GOD.


Jesus authenticated Daniel in Matt 24:15


Mt 24:15 Therefore when you see the "abomination of desolation," spoken of by Daniel the prophet, standing in the holy place (whoever reads, let him understand),

- Most conservative scholars have believed Daniel wrote his book approximately 537 B.C. – centuries before the events he prophesied occurred
- Liberal scholars have claimed that Daniel wrote his book approximately 165 B.C. – just a few years after the events he details had already happened










There are eight scrolls of the Book of Daniel among the Dead Sea Scrolls
Some of these were copied (not written) 150-100 B.C.
Since Daniel was already considered inspired Scripture by the Qumran faithful by this time, it is unreasonable to believe Daniel had written his book only some 15-18 yrs










Heb 11:6 But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.

Heb 11:3, 7-8 By faith we understand that the ©worlds were framed by the word of God, so that the things which are seen were not made of things which are visible. ... ⁷ By faith Noah, being divinely warned of things not yet seen, moved with godly fear, prepared an ark for the saving of his household, by which he condemned the world and became heir of the righteousness which is according to faith. ⁸ By faith Abraham obeyed when he was called to go out to the place which he would receive as an inheritance. And he went out, not knowing where he was going.



- Daniel is a historic person who actually lived during the time of Nebuchadnezzar, King of Babylon
- Daniel was a prophet who predicted things that would happen in the future – his and ours
- Much of the second half of Daniel deals with events during the Gentile age and the Great Tribulation
- The 9th chapter of Daniel is the master key to all of end time prophecy
- Without a thorough understanding of Daniel, end time prophecy makes little sense
