The Samaritans successfully get the building of the Temple stopped and it remains stopped until 520 BC



Zechariah encouraged the people by presenting to them the coming glory of the Messiah.



¹⁵ And **I am very sore displeased with the heathen that are at ease:** for I was but a little displeased, and they helped forward the affliction.

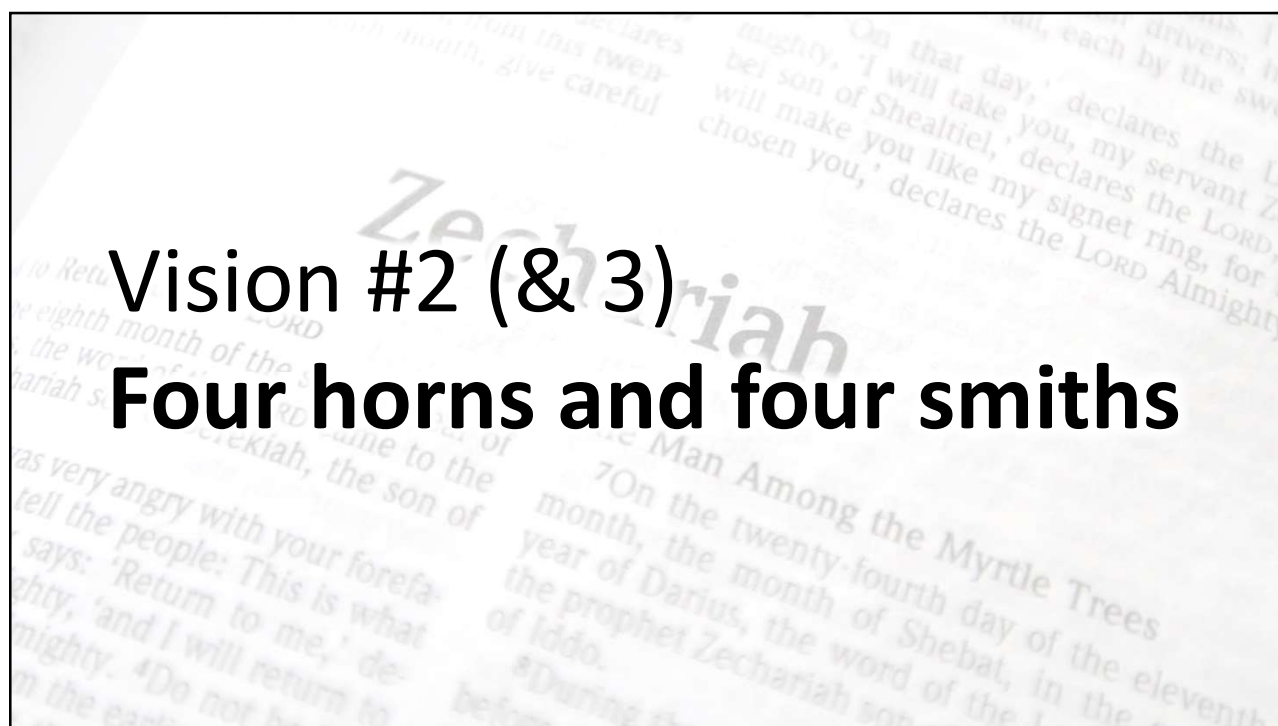
