**Order of revelations:** 


- Month 1 Haggai Rebuild (1:1) (2<sup>nd</sup> Year of Darius, 6

- Month 4 Haggai Confirmation (9 mo. 24<sup>th</sup> day)
- 19 months later Zechariah's ten visions in one night with encouraging promises of the future.

# Vision #1 The Angel of the LORD taking note of the state of the world.







About the middle of the 5th century Theodoret speaks of Babylon as being inhabited only by Jews, who had still three Jewish Universities, and in the last year of the same century the "Babylonian Talmud" was issued, and recognized as authoritative by the Jews of the whole world.

- Isa 13:19-20 And Babylon, the glory of kingdoms, the beauty of the Chaldees' excellency, shall be as when God overthrew Sodom and Gomorrah. It shall never be inhabited, neither shall it be dwelt in from generation to generation: neither shall the Arabian pitch tent there; neither shall the shepherds make their fold there.
- Jer 50:39-40 Therefore the wild beasts of the desert with the wild beasts of the islands shall dwell there, and the owls shall dwell therein: and it shall be no more inhabited for ever; neither shall it be dwelt in from generation to generation. As God overthrew Sodom and Gomorrah and the neighbour cities thereof, saith the Lord; so shall no man abide there, neither shall any son of man dwell therein.
- Jer 51:26 And they shall not take of thee a stone for a corner, nor a stone for foundations; but thou shalt be desolate for ever, saith the Lord.
- Jer 51:37 And Babylon shall become heaps, a dwellingplace for dragons, an astonishment, and an hissing, without an inhabitant.
- Jer 51:58 The broad walls of Babylon shall be utterly broken, and her high gates shall be burned with fire; and the people shall labour in vain, and the folk in the fire, and they shall be weary.
- Jer 51:63-64 And it shall be, when thou hast made an end of reading this book, that
  thou shalt bind a stone to it, and cast it into the midst of Euphrates: And thou shalt
  say, Thus shall Babylon sink, and shall not rise from the evil that I will bring upon her:
  and they shall be weary. Thus far are the words of Jeremiah.




