1 Cor 15:47

The first man was of the earth, made of dust; the second Man is the Lord from heaven.

The original Hebrew word for 'man' is '**Adam**' {אָדָם} and the word for 'ground' is '**Adamah**' {אֲדָמָה}, because 'the LORD God formed the man of dust from the ground and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life, and the man became a living creature.'

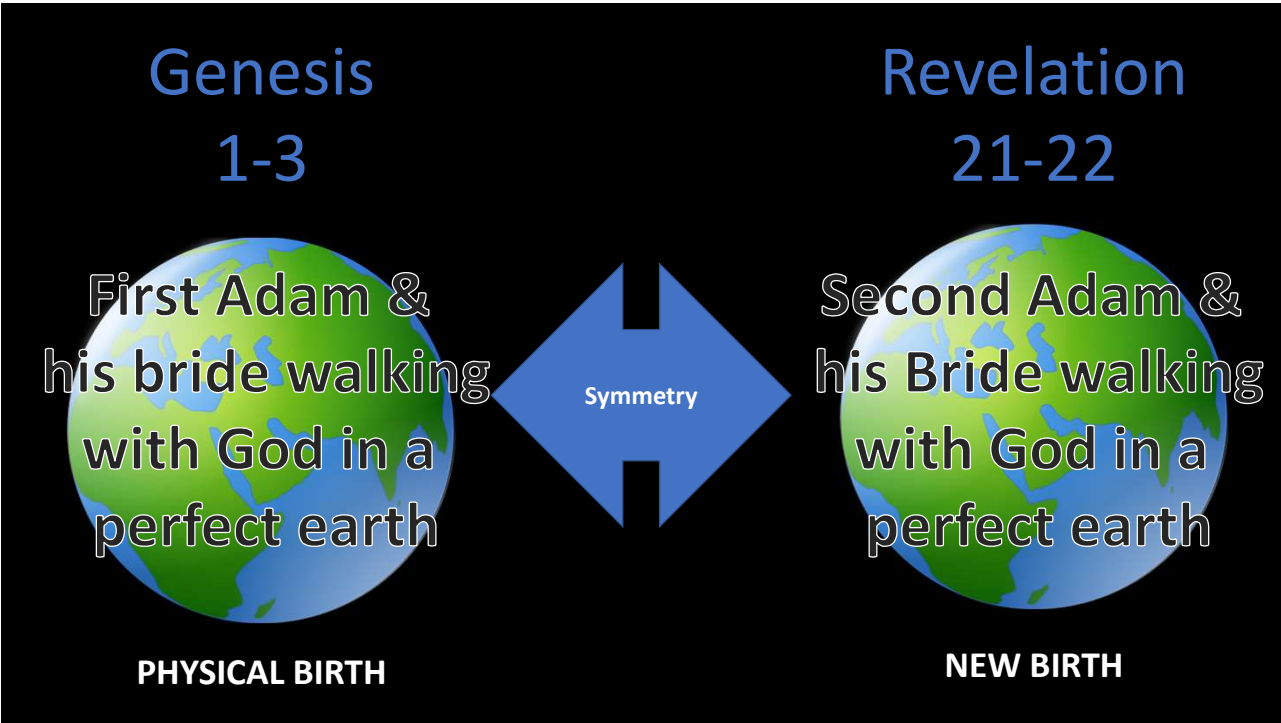

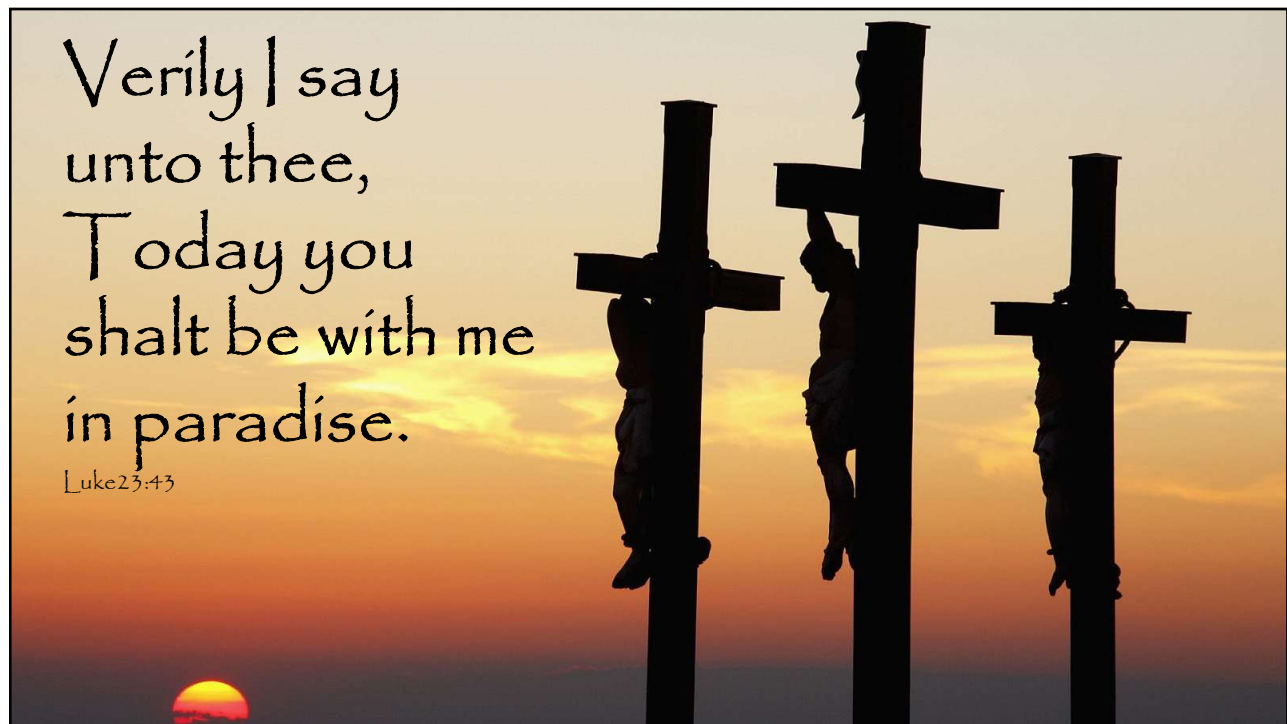
Summary: Contrast of the Two Bodies

- There is body that decays (sown in corruption), and body that will not decay (raised in incorruption). (V. 42)
- It is sown in dishonor and humiliation; it is raised in honor and glory. (V. 43)
- It is sown in infirmity and weakness; it is raised in strength and endued with power. (V. 43)
- It is sown a natural (physical) body; it is raised a supernatural (a spiritual) body. [As surely as] there is a physical body, there is also a spiritual body. (Amplified KJV, V. 44)
- There is a body, in the lineage of Adam, designed for this life on earth, a natural body subject to pain and death.
- There is a body, after Christ, a supernatural body endued with power and under the control of the Holy Spirit, designed for eternity.

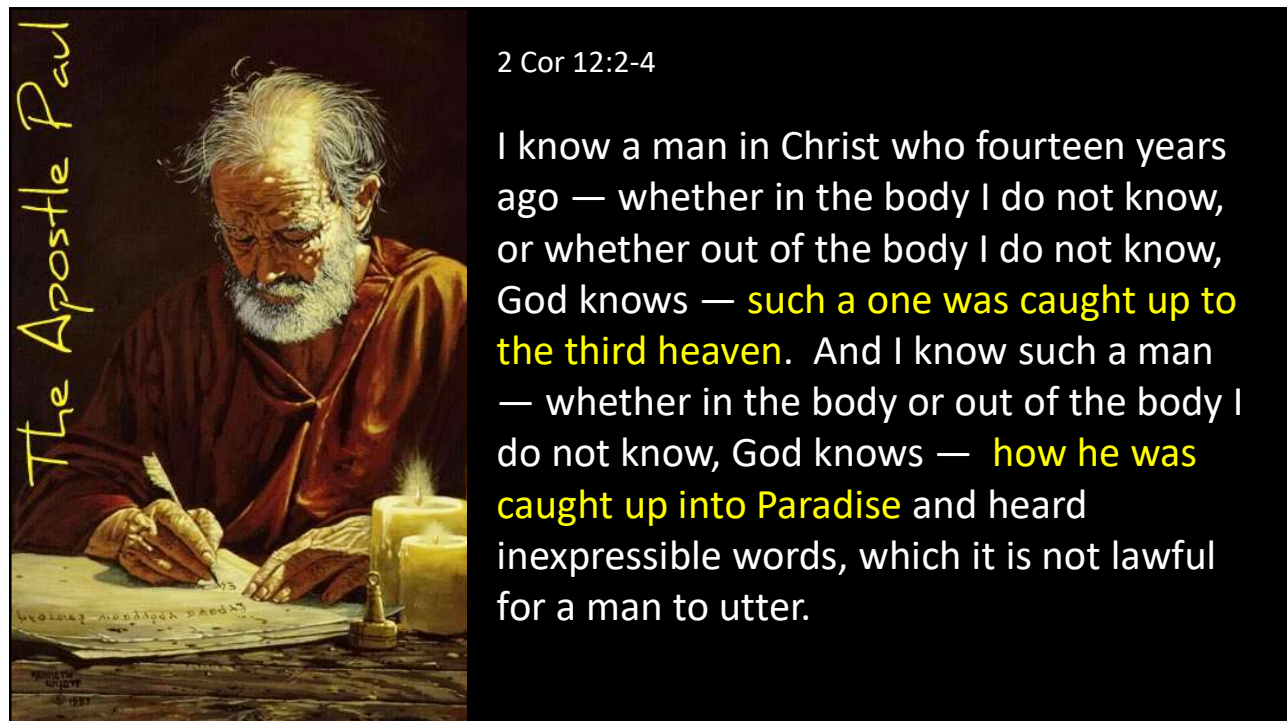
