






- Spiritual gifts are not the "fruit of the Spirit" mentioned in Gal 5:22-23.









Rom 12:3-6 as God has dealt to each one a measure of faith. ⁴For as we have many members in one body, but all the members do not have the same function, ⁵so we, being many, are one body in Christ, and individually members of one another. ⁶Having then gifts differing according to the grace that is given to us, let us use them:

- 1 Cor 12:7,11 But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to each one for the profit of all: ... But one and the same Spirit works all these things, distributing to each one individually as He wills.
- 1 Pet 4:10 As each one has received a gift, minister it to one another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God.
