






# 70 years in captivity in Babylon

606 BC to 536 BC







The Samaritans successfully get the building of the Temple stopped and it remains stopped until 520 BC









#### KINGDOM (Age of the Messiah /1000 Year Millennial Reign of Christ)

<sup>7</sup> But it shall be one day which shall be known to the Lord, not day, nor night: but it shall come to pass, that at evening time it shall be light.




## Isa 13:9-11




#### Ezek 47:1-2


# Zech 14:14-17

14 And Judah also shall fight at Jerusalem; and the wealth of all the heathen round about shall be gathered together, gold, and silver, and apparel, in great abundance.


15 And so shall be the plague of the horse, of the mule, of the camel, and of the ass, and of all the beasts that shall be in these tents, as this plague.


