





Shintoism: Japan is the only important place on earth and the Japanese people are the only important people on earth. Revolves around supernatural entities called the kami who are believed to inhabit all things, including forces of nature and prominent landscape locations. Little emphasis is placed on specific moral codes or particular afterlife beliefs, although the dead are deemed capable of becoming kami.



Mormonism: heaven is inhabited by a god who was once a man but became a god. His throne is on or near a planet/star named Kolob. Joseph Smith taught that God the Father has a wife in heaven, Elah the Mother in Heaven, who is the mother of all spirits. Brigham Young taught that God has a harem of such wives who give birth to all spirits. The Mormon Church teaches there is a celestial heaven where all faithful Mormons go and a terrestrial heaven where everyone else goes. They also teach that faithful Mormon husbands and wives can ascend to god-status in the afterlife.






3. If it doesn't matter what we believe about Eschatology, does it matter what we believe about other biblical subjects?

10. If Pre-Millennialists are correct, we can know, with relative certainty, exactly what the books of Daniel and the Revelation teach and their messages have tremendous relevance to us today.

- What are God's future plans for Israel if He has any?
- Did the Church replace Israel?
- What is the 70th week of Daniel 9?
- What does 2 Thess 2:3-12 mean when it speaks of the desecration of a future Jewish temple and the demand of the "Lawless One" to be worshipped as God?
- Who is the "beast" ("the" Anti-Christ) of Daniel 8 & 9 and Revelation 11, 13, 19?
- What is the "abomination of desolation" and the "great tribulation" Jesus spoke of in Mt 24?
- Why will there be a Great Tribulation?
- Will the Church go through the Great Tribulation?
- Is the "imminent return of Jesus" a biblical principle?
