490 yrs on God's stopwatch for Israel (Dan 9:25-27)

- 1st 7 weeks (49 yrs.) = Jerusalem's wall/streets rebuilt
- Next 62 weeks (434 yrs.) = Jerusalem's rebuilding to Messiah crucified
- Total time until Messiah crucified = 69 weeks (483 yrs.)
- 70th week (7 yrs.) = Grt Trib



- Jerusalem destroyed after it was rebuilt in the days of Ezra & Nehemiah
- This destruction occurred in 70 A.D. by the Roman Gen. Titus
- Jesus prophesied this: Mt 24:1-2, Lk 19:41-44

Jerusalem & the temple)

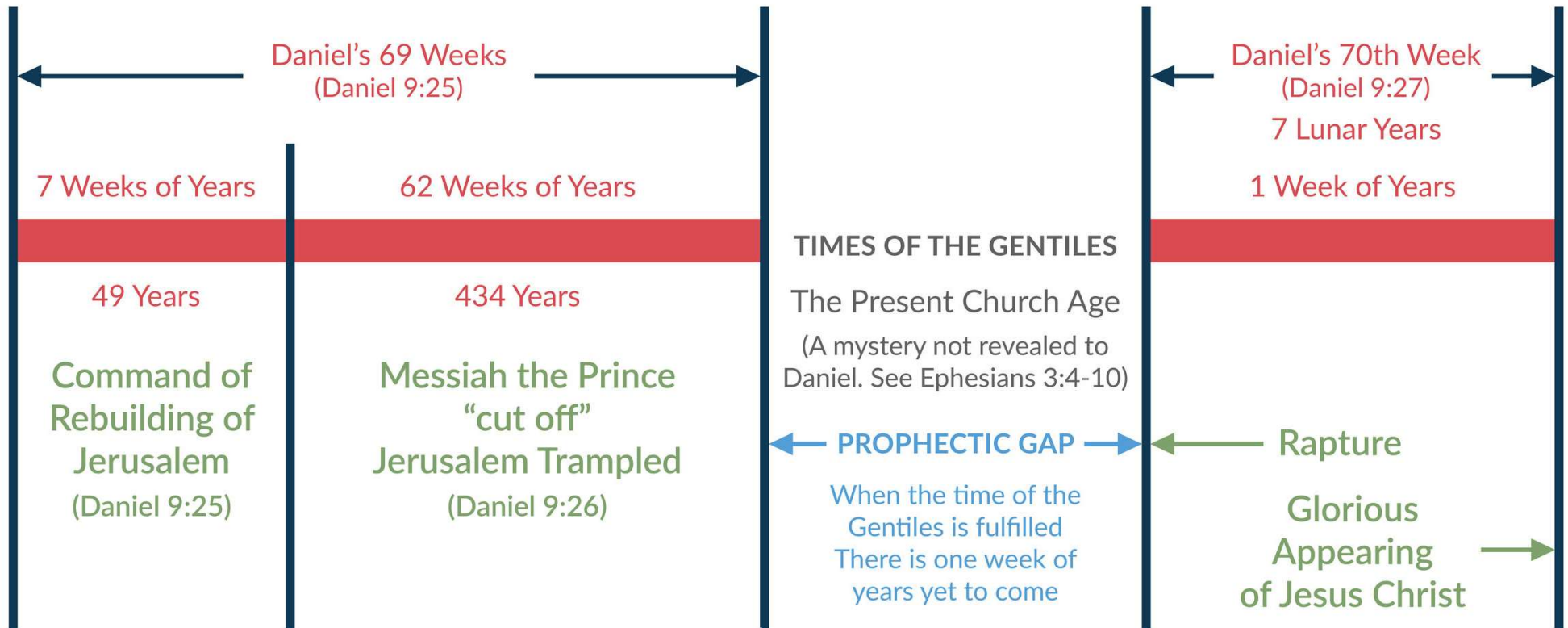
Question 2: What shall be the sign of your coming & of

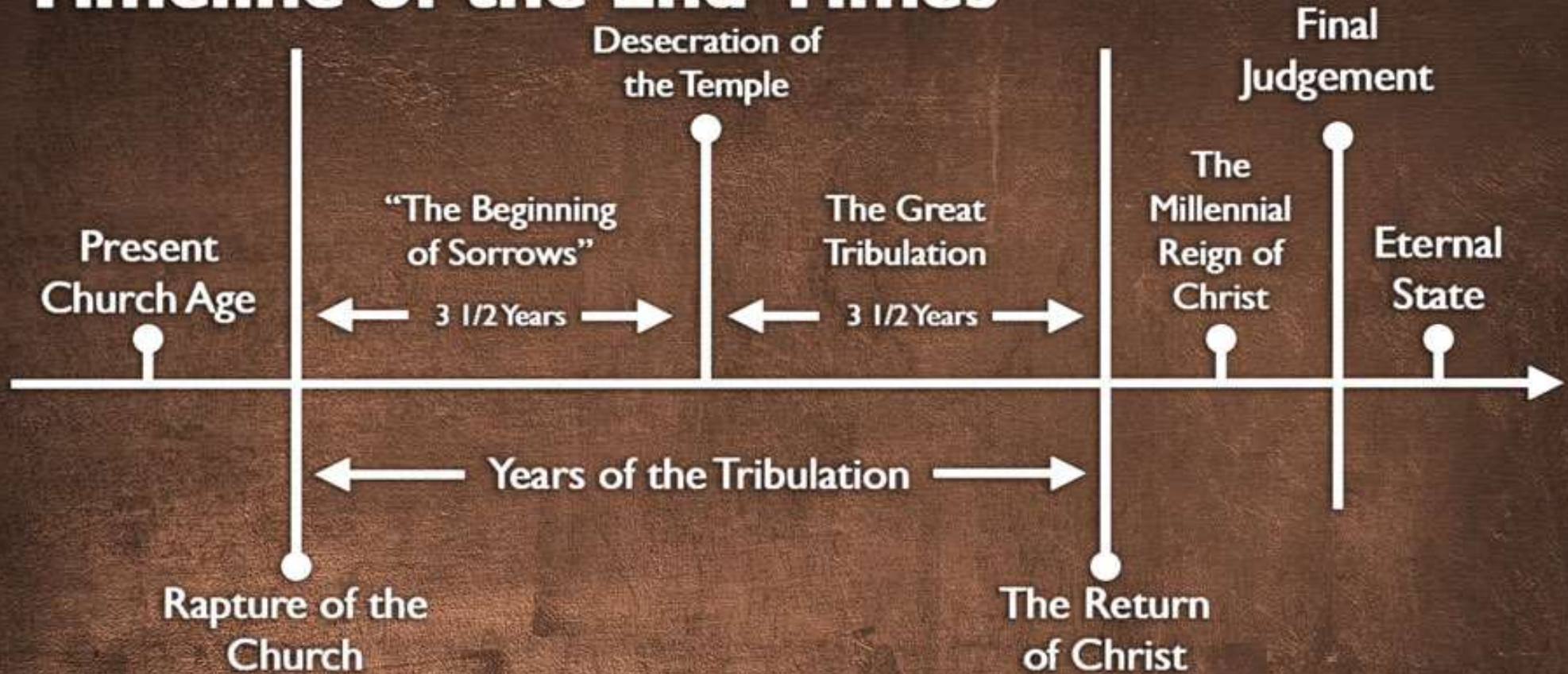

Timeline of the End Times

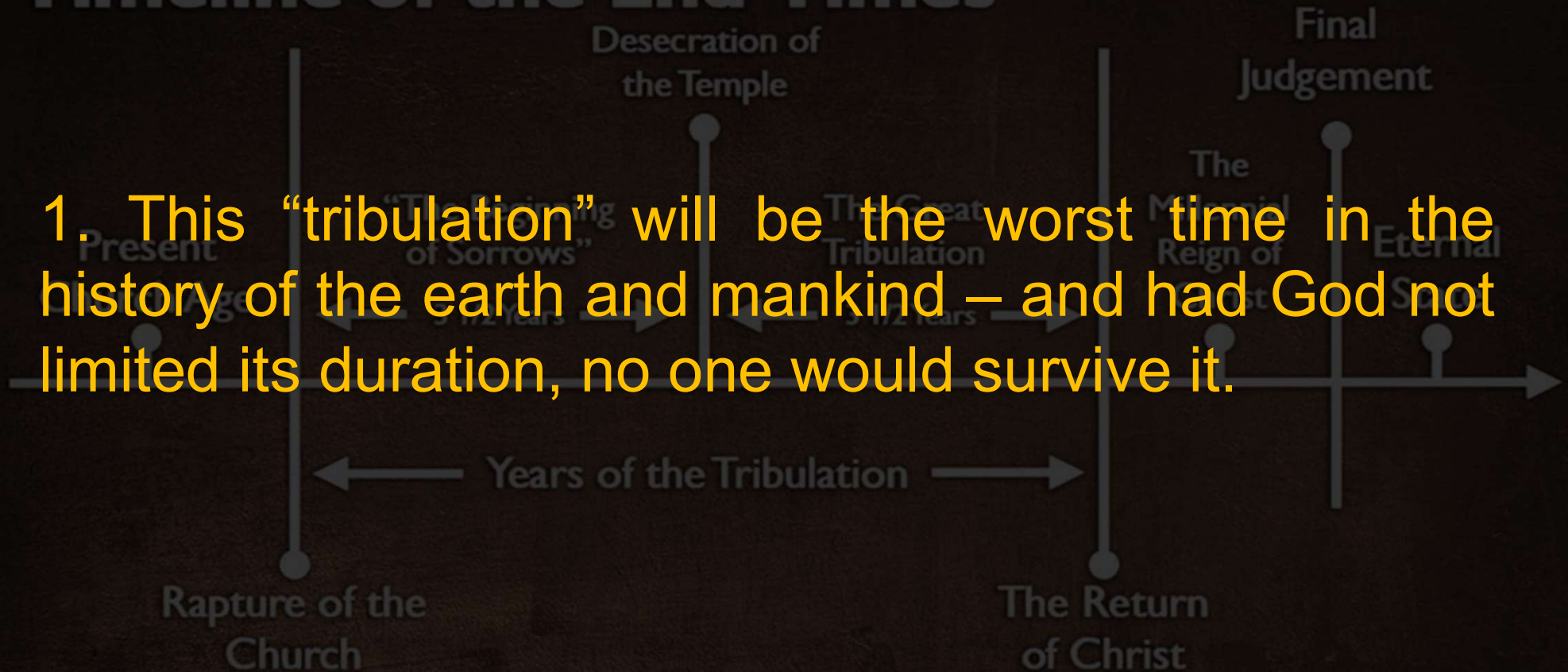


Timeline of the End Times

Dan 9:26c-27 The end of it shall be with a flood, and till the end of the war desolations are determined. Then he [Beast/Anti-Christ] shall confirm a covenant with many for one week; but in the middle of the week he shall bring an end to sacrifice and offering. And on the wing of abominations shall be one who makes desolate, even until the consummation, which is determined, is poured out on the desolate.”

Timeline of the End Times

1. This “tribulation” will be the worst time in the history of the earth and mankind – and had God not limited its duration, no one would survive it.



Mt 24:21-22 For then there will be great tribulation, such as has not been since the beginning of the world until this time, no, nor ever shall be. ²² And unless those days were shortened, no flesh would be saved; but for the elect's sake those days will be shortened.

Jer 30:7 Alas! For that day is great, so that none is like it; and it is the time of Jacob's trouble, but he shall be saved out of it.

Is 26:20-21 Come, my people, enter your chambers, and shut your doors behind you; hide yourself, as it were, for a little moment, until the indignation is past. ²¹ For behold, the Lord comes out of His place to punish the inhabitants of the earth for their iniquity; the earth will also disclose her blood, and will no more cover her slain.


Timeline of the End Times

2. The 7 years are divided into two, 3 ½ year periods with the second 3 ½ being the worst

Rev 12:12 Therefore rejoice, O heavens, and you who dwell in them! Woe to the inhabitants of the earth and the sea! For the devil has come down to you, having great wrath, because he knows that he has a short time.”

Timeline of the End Times

Dan 9:27 Then he [Beast/Anti-Christ] shall confirm a covenant with many for one week; but in the **middle of the week** he shall bring an end to sacrifice and offering. And on the wing of **abominations shall be one who makes desolate**, even until the consummation, which is determined, is poured out on the desolate.”

3. The second 3 ½ years is known in Scripture as:

- Time, times, and a half time

Dan 7:25 He shall speak pompous words against the Most High, shall persecute the saints of the Most High, and shall intend to change times and law. Then the saints shall be given into his hand for a time and times and half a time.

12:7 Then I heard the man clothed in linen, who was above the waters of the river, when he held up his right hand and his left hand to heaven, and swore by Him who lives forever, that it shall be for a time, times, and half a time; and when the power of the holy people has been completely shattered, all these things shall be finished.

12:14 But the woman was given two wings of a great eagle, that she might fly into the wilderness to her place, where she is nourished for a time and times and half a time, from the presence of the serpent.

Timeline of the End Times

- 1260 days

Rev 11:3 And I will give power to my two witnesses, and they will prophesy one thousand two hundred and sixty days, clothed in sackcloth.”

12:6 Then the woman fled into the wilderness, where she has a place prepared by God, that they should feed her there one thousand two hundred and sixty days.

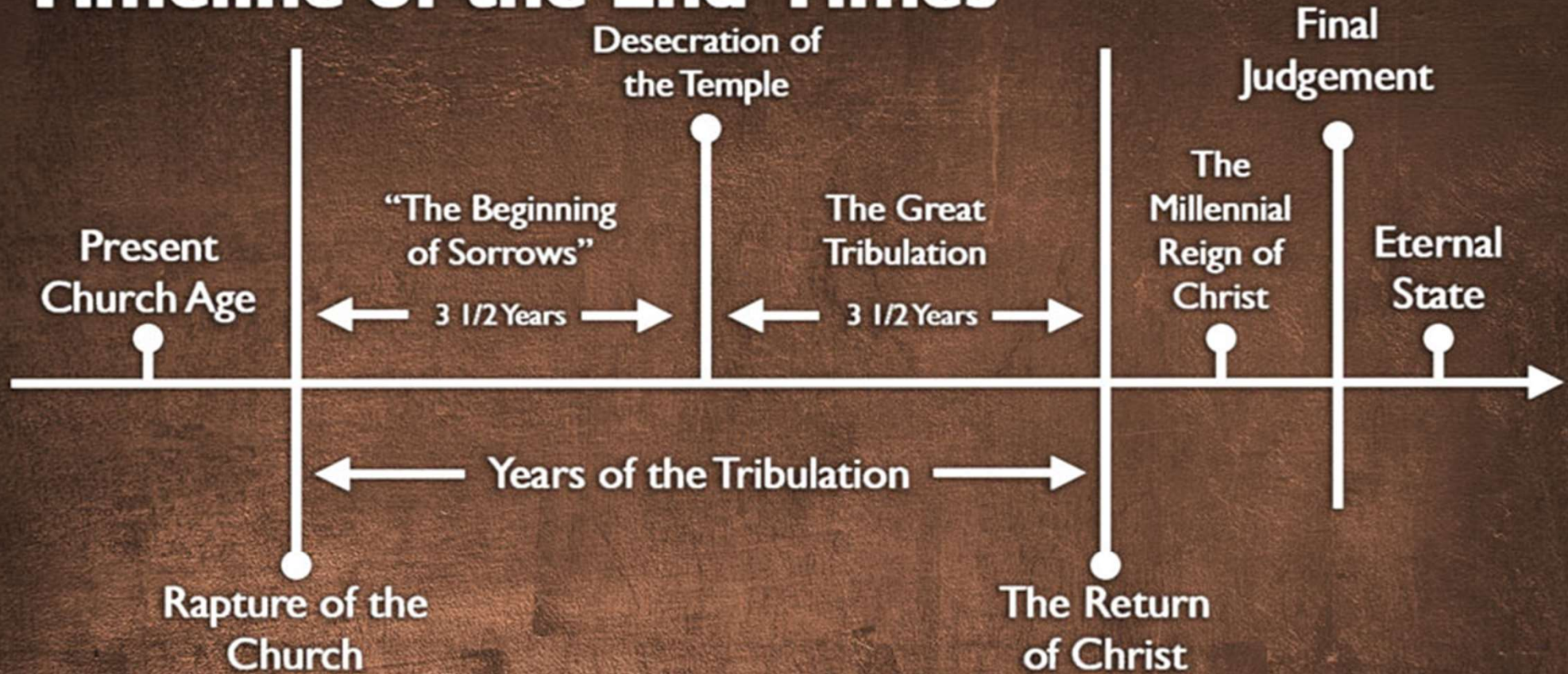
Timeline of the End Times

- 42 months

Rev 11:2 But leave out the court which is outside the temple, and do not measure it, for it has been given to the Gentiles. And they will tread the holy city underfoot for forty-two months.

Rev 13:5 And he was given a mouth speaking great things and blasphemies, and he was given authority to continue for forty-two months.

Timeline of the End Times

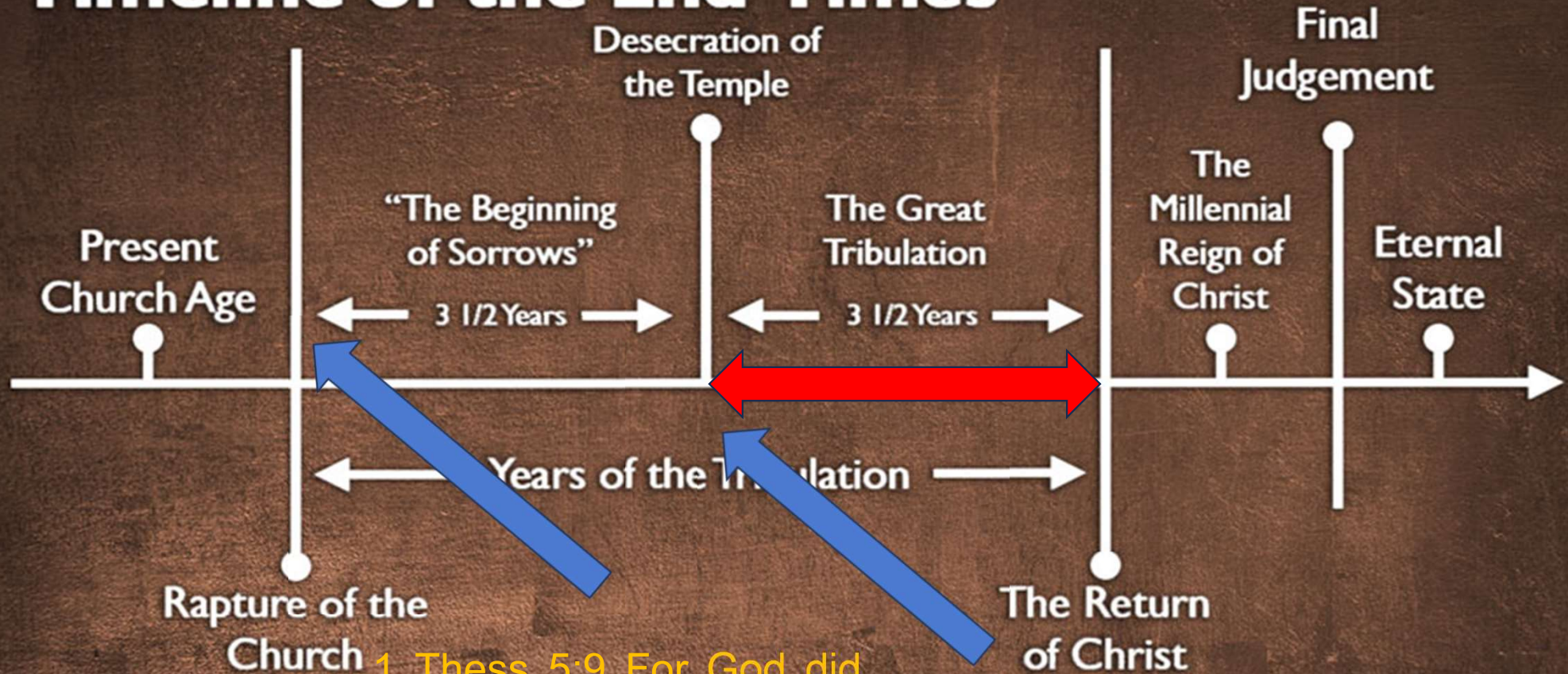


Dan 12:11 “And from the time that the daily sacrifice is taken away, and the abomination of desolation is set up, there shall be one thousand two hundred and ninety days.

Mt 24:15 “Therefore when you see the ‘abomination of desolation,’ spoken of by Daniel the prophet, standing in the holy place” (whoever reads, let him understand),

2 Thess 2:3-4 Let no one deceive you by any means; for that Day will not come unless the falling away comes first, and the man of sin is revealed, the son of perdition, ⁴ who opposes and exalts himself above all that is called God or that is worshiped, so that he sits as God in the temple of God, showing himself that he is God.

1 Thess 1:10 Jesus who delivers us from the wrath to come.
