


Isa 9:6-7






John 10:20-24

Rev 17:10 And there are seven kings: five are fallen, and one is (Rome), and the other is not yet come; and when he cometh, he must continue a short space.


Ten Kings of Last World Empire






Dedication – 164BC

Antiochus Epiphanes IV


Saleucid King — 175BC-64BC

Antiochus persecuted Jews, forbidding circumcision under penalty of death & ordered a sow be offered on the Jewish altar.









The Synoptic Gospels

- John Jesus is the Son of God (Isaiah 4:2, Jeremiah 23:6)





If any man thirst, let him come unto me, and drink. He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water.










Did Jesus claim to be God? YES!

- He claimed to be the 'I AM' of the Burning Bush (YHWH)
- He claimed to be the Light of the world (YHWH)
- He claimed to be the Living Water (YHWH)
- He claimed to be the Good Shepherd (YHWH)
- He claimed to be granter of Eternal Life (YHWH)
- He claimed to be the Messiah, Son of Man and Son of God.


Isaiah 45:21:
