


1 Cor 15:51-52

52 In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.









Rev 7:4-8

- ⁴ And I heard the number of them which were sealed: and there were sealed an hundred and forty and four thousand of all the tribes of the children of Israel.
- ⁵ Of the tribe of Juda were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Reuben were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Gad were sealed twelve thousand.
- ⁶ Of the tribe of Aser were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Nepthali were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Manasses were sealed twelve thousand.
- ⁷ Of the tribe of Simeon were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Levi were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Issachar were sealed twelve thousand.
- ⁸ Of the tribe of Zabulon were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Joseph were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Benjamin were sealed twelve thousand.

Distinguishing Characteristics:

Thrones

 Rev 3:21 To him that overcometh will I grant to sit with me in my throne, even as I also overcame, and am set down with my Father in his throne.

White Raiment

- Rev 3:5 He that overcometh, the same shall be clothed in white raiment (Sardis)
- Rev 3:18 I counsel thee to buy of me gold tried in the fire, that thou mayest be rich;
 and white raiment (Laodicea)
- Rev 19:8 And to her was granted that she should be arrayed in fine linen, clean and white: for the fine linen is the righteousness of saints. (Bride)

Distinguishing Characteristics:

- Thrones Rev 3:21
- White Raiment Rev 3:21
- Wearing Stefanos Crowns Rev 2:10; 3:11
 - Rev 2:10 Fear none of those things which thou shalt suffer: behold, the devil shall cast some of you into prison, that ye may be tried; and ye shall have tribulation ten days: be thou faithful unto death, and I will give thee a crown of life. (Smyrna)
 - Rev 3:11 Behold, I come quickly: hold that fast which thou hast, that no man take thy crown. (Philadelphia)

- White Raiment Rev 3:21
- Wearing Stefanos Crowns Rev 2:10; 3:11
- Song of Redeemed Rev 5:9,10
 - Rev 5:9-10 And they sung a new song, saying, Thou art worthy to take the book, and to open the seals thereof: for thou wast slain, and hast redeemed us to God by thy blood out of every kindred, and tongue, and people, and nation; And hast made us unto our God kings and priests: and we shall reign on the earth.



 - Rev 5:10 And hast made us unto our God kings and priests: and we shall reign on the earth.













Rev 4:9-11

Crowns?

- Crown of Life (Jas 1:12; Rev 2:10) for those who have suffered for His sake.
- Crown of Righteousness (2 Tim 4:8) for those who loved His appearing.
- Crown of Glory (1 Pet 5:4) for those who fed the flock.
- Crown Incorruptible (1 Cor 9:25) for those who press on steadfastly.
- Crown of Rejoicing (1 Thess 2:19) for those who win souls.
