Revelation (Lesson 11) Chapter 3

The city was known commercially for three things:

- 1. It was a strong financial center with quite a banking industry
- 2. It had a strong textile manufacturing business particularly with black wool what came from a particular breed of sheep there in the Lycos Valley.
- School of Medicine with an emphasis on ophthalmology. They produced an eye salve made from mixing oil and collyrium powder.



In the letter to Colossae (with explicit reference to Laodicea), Christian doctrine was under attack by philosophies of men - in particular, doubting the eternal nature of Christ and the concept of Jesus being God incarnate.

Meals Between Jews and Gentiles



There is a general understanding from various historical sources that Jews and Gentiles did not share meals in antiquity. Meals for ancient people were reserved for those of their inner circle.

Many pagan writers noted that Jews usually do not eat with anyone but with other Jews. Jews also routinely rejected non-Jewish food, especially if it could be associated with pagan worship and, apparently this has been a longstanding practice, at least since the days of Babylonian exile.

Eating Together?



Satyr – a companion of Dionysius, the god of the grape harvest.

Sharing food and drink and even casual association with pagans was problematic for Jews who sought to be faithful to the Torah. Because there was no "secular" sphere in the ancient world, everything Gentiles and Jews did in life had to do with their respective worship.

Associating with non-Jews meant associating with their lifestyle and their deities. This would introduce defilement and sin, so Jews of that era chose to stay away from Gentiles entirely and would not even enter their houses.


