Action Plan for Reclaiming Oklahoma

1. Change the schools

- a. Teachers are to teach knowledge, not to indoctrinate
 - i. Eliminate personal political rants
 - ii. Eliminate campaign pins, bumper stickers, etc., on teachers, in classrooms, on doors.
- b. Acknowledge that evolution is a theory accepted by faith and that intelligent design is also a recognized theory.
- c. Abstinence teaching.
- d. Keep all Planned Parenthood out of our schools.

2. Put your children in private Christian school or perhaps use your church facilities for a collective home school program.

- a. Lobby for Voucher Plan

3. Do not send your kids to public colleges.

- a. Why would a sane person pay exorbitant fees to have someone teach their children to become little atheists and socialists?
- b. Why should our tax dollars go to fund organizations in which 95% of the professors are liberal and even socialist. Is this a true representation of mainstream America?
- c. Lobby for the sale and privatization of all higher education. Government money would then be available to provide scholarships.

4. We must demand that colleges return to education and not indoctrination or risk the threat of being defunded.

5. Organize classes in our churches that teach the truth about America's Christian Heritage, the Great Awakening, the Black Regiment, The Declaration of Independence, the Constitution, and the faith of our founding Fathers. Teach this to all ages in a Sunday Evening Training Class immediately before the evening services. Possible Text Book sources would include:

- a. One Nation Under God by Dr. David C. Gibbs, Jr., and Jerry Newcombe
- b. Light and Glory by Peter Marshall
- c. Light and Glory for Children & Activity Book
- d. Memorize and study parts of Constitution, Declaration of Independence, Northwest Ordinance of 1787, Federalist Papers, etc.
- e. **Ps 48:13** *Mark ye well her bulwarks, consider her palaces; that ye may tell it to the generation following.*

8. Elect committed Christians to Public Office.

9. **Publicize Truth.** Promote tidbits of truth like the "Moment of Truth" along with a web sight address where a person can go for further information.
 - a. Ads in Newspapers
 - b. Ads in School Newspapers
 - c. Billboards on Major Highways
 - d. Peaceful protests at abortion clinics
 - e. Show up at school board meetings, City council meetings, State Capital, Town Hall meetings with Washington officials, etc.

10. **Evangelize.** Nothing has changed since Eden. This battle is still the promotion of Truth verses the spreading of the lie – whosoever believeth is not condemned, whosever believeth not is condemned already. Personal evangelism has never been popular and never will, however it is still the principle taught in the Bible – "you shall be my witnesses" – one person living a life where there walk matches their talk telling another how they can be born again.

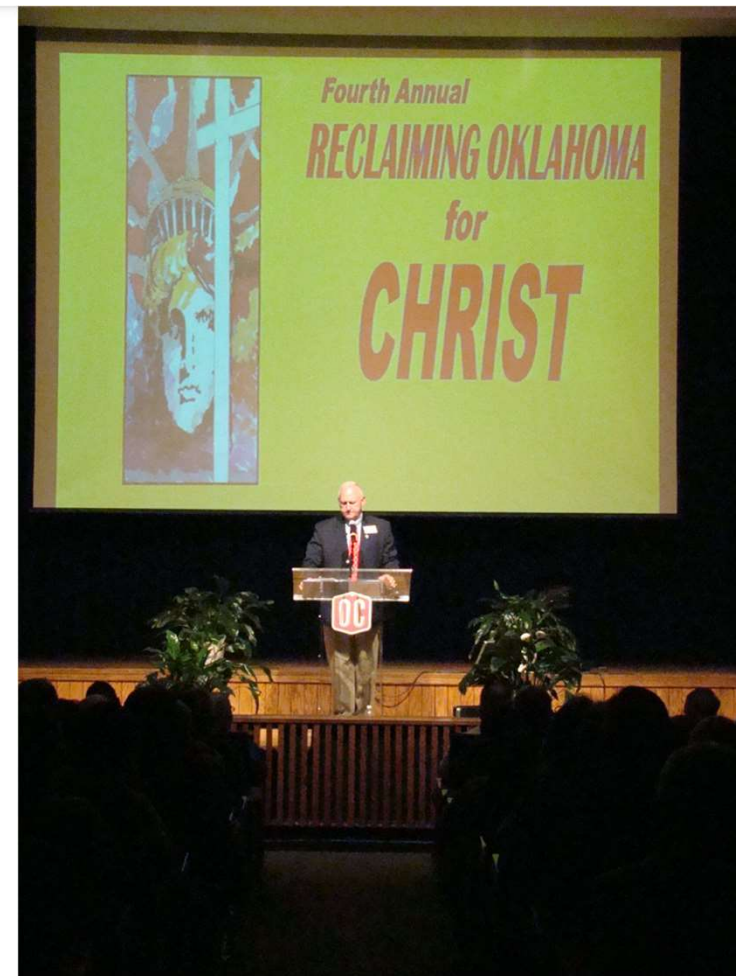

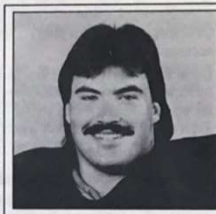

He helps kids to realize that the beautiful, slender girl with the bottle of beer probably doesn't really drink it at all—instead she eats healthy and exercises to stay in shape so she can work in television. And though the man in the cigarette ad has a sparkling smile, the ad never mentions nicotine stains on fingers or teeth or the dangers of smoke filled lungs. The students shout Paul's theme back at him in an all-school roar: "Don't Believe the Lies!" Hopefully, the children of Will Rogers Elementary never will.

Paul Blair's dynamic interaction with the kids showcases his commitment to helping them stay away from harmful influences.

Over the years Edmond has cheered on their "Hometown Hero." Born and raised in Edmond, the son of a Baptist minister, Paul graduated from Edmond Memorial High and went on to a dazzling football career as an offensive tackle for Oklahoma State University. Edmond was proud in 1986 when Paul Blair was fourth-round draft pick for the Chicago Bears. Paul distinguished himself during three years with the Bears and a year with the Minnesota Vikings.

Four knee surgeries have put an end to the NFL chapter of Paul's life, but Paul has come home to Edmond to devote himself full-time to Electronic Merchandising, Incorporated. Paul and his brother started this full-service vending company five years ago, and the company has expanded considerably in the past fifteen months since Paul returned to live year-round in Edmond. Five Point Plan to Transform America

1) Liberty Church

Introduction

We have been working for ten years in an attempt to awaken pastors. The modern pastor has been taught in summary to be the CEO of an organization designed to attract members rather than being God's prophetic voice and transforming lives. Most pastors have been taught to avoid controversy while delivering their summary-approved "hose points and a story" messages.

We have discovered most pastors who will not engage on important issues are afraid of:

- 1) Their Board of Elders/Deacons
- 2) Losing members in their congregations and money in offerings
- 3) Being criticized as a homophobic, Islamaphobic or being labeled an intolerant.
- 4) Losing their job

As Barna's study recently concluded, most pastors are aware that the IRS cannot take away tax exemptions and most pastors are aware that issues such as abortion, homosexual marriage and the national debt are addressed in the Bible. Introduction

As I travel the country, I am continually asked, "Is there a church like yours around here?" or "Is there a pastor around here that preaches like you do?"

Introduction

At one time, actual living preachers made their rounds by horseback. That was the technology of the day. Now, we must use the technology of our day.

I propose four "Liberty Church" facilities. Each facility would need at minimum to start a campus pastor, secretary, music ministry, youth ministry, women and A/V tech. Only the secretary and pastor would need to full time paid positions, initially. Each facility would have their own music, announcements and on-site invitation. The women would be two stranded on a state of the art HD screen and amplification. My time will be split between Oklahoma City and Orlando. As we add Nashville and Boston, I will spend several weeks in each establishing the new church. Then, would speak in each location at least once quarterly, while devoting most of my time to Oklahoma City and Orlando. Each church would need state of the art A/V systems, startup salaries for staff for one year and sufficient funds for ads, radio and advertising for one year.

Logistically and for consistency of the message being taught across this church body, I would propose leading Live ~~Unscripted~~ on Sunday mornings and Sunday evenings. I

can foresee having the campus pastor teach an auditorium adult Bible Class that complements the morning worship and also teaching the Wednesday Bible Study and Prayer Meeting.

We would be flexible and fully able to incorporate supplemental lessons plans such as "The Truth Project" and "I Don't Have Enough Faith to be an Atheist" in lieu of the Sunday evening service or the Morning Bible Class or the Wednesday class. We also have great connections and would be able to bring in expert teachers on apologetics, worldview, Islam and other topics.

I can foresee a great relationship between the different city church families. For example, I can see Rock Orlando becoming the prototype ministry to reach into the inner cities creating a Rock Boston, Rock Nashville and Rock Oklahoma City. I can also envision expanding that ministry to reaching the Hispanic Communities.

Truth is true for all people at all times. There is not a Black truth, Hispanic truth and a White truth. There is only truth. Truth transcends race, gender and economic backgrounds. This would be a great opportunity to reach all with the truth about the family, sexuality, personal responsibility, Biblical civility, and Biblical principles of government. We could begin to transform the inner cities in these communities and serve as a model to be duplicated in others.

I can also see this opportunity for mission trips within our family of churches. Tourists and college students from ORC could go to Orlando for a week and work in Rock Orlando, then take a day or two and enjoy the beach or Disney. They could enjoy both Fun & ministry rather than the typical Spring break. I can also bring in college students from ORC and Orlando going to Boston to work 4 days with Rock Boston, then take three days to tour Plymouth, the Liberty Trail, Lexington, Concord, etc.

I can also see some friendly competition between the campuses. We could all take the PEER'S Wednesday test, then begin a ten week study program on Biblical worldview and make the test. We could see which church truly graded the highest or made the most increase. If we can actually get those who call themselves Christians to begin thinking like Christians, then the end result will be they start acting like Christians. That would be an Awakening.

- 1) **Liberty Baptist Church of Oklahoma City.** My church is in the process of looking ground for a 1400 seat auditorium, church and school. Having preached here for 15 years, I have a mature congregation with a high Biblical worldview excited about engaging the culture and transforming it.

a. We have all the pieces in place currently. (Anticipated congregation Year One: 1200)

b. Supplement with radio ministry. Already in existence. M-F, 30min, \$40K.

c. We are a fully functional & healthy church that is Debt free.

- i. I addressed the subject with my Deacon Board on 10/4. They are fired up about multiplying our campuses and want to charge ahead, seeing the value in expanding our reach.

2) **Liberty Baptist Church of Downtown Orlando.**

Downtown Baptist Church of Orlando is a neighborhood old facility with a membership history. However, the church is currently on its support. As I have spoken in Florida at least fifty times and having a solid base in Orlando, this would be a perfect complement. Orlando is a destination resort city that would further expand our audience as we introduce our church and ministry to those visiting Orlando. Also, being in the middle of a state that is nearly 50/50 red to blue, this is a critical location. I would plan to spend two weeks in Orlando out of every month. Two Sundays, I would be in Orlando ~~Unscripted~~ the message back to Oklahoma City. Two Sundays, I would be in Oklahoma City ~~Unscripted~~ the message to Orlando.

a. We have the musicians (Dixie Flat) and an on-campus minister (Dexter Sanders) already in place. Dexter also already has Rock Orlando fully functioning. It just needs a home. (Anticipated congregation Year One: 1500)

b. Radio ministry – either 15 min or 30 min, daily M-F. Estimated: \$40K.

i. We need to examine options.

c. We have the financial backing in place and a core to start.

d. Start a promotional campaign right away – "Liberty is coming to Orlando."

e. Start the radio ministry right away, with church opening on 1/2/15.

f. Rock Orlando in small auditorium at the time appears our morning service.

3) **Liberty Baptist Church of Nashville.**

You will read about "Reclaiming America for Christ Radio" later in this presentation. Reclaiming America Radio is run by Dan Zimmerman of Nashville. Dan has a passionate heart for evangelism, is a very capable preacher and talk show host. Dan could move as campus pastor for Nashville. We would begin with a school auditorium and expand as needed.

a. Anticipated congregation Year One: 200.

b. Supplement with radio ministry. Beginning 10/28. M-F, 10min, \$8500.

c. We have a franchisee in place to assist the campus.

4) **Liberty Baptist Church of Boston.**

My radio ministry, *Expanding the Word*, has been on WNCN-AM650 in Boston every weekday morning at 10:30 am for over one year. In addition, Reclaiming America for Christ Radio Network has been on the air from 7 PM to 5 AM weekdays for that same time period. Churches in Boston are closing and attendance is at record lows. We believe that we could acquire a facility at no charge by simply joining with or taking over a church on its support. David Tardio is an employee of Salem Radio in Boston. He was previously trained by Dr. D. James Kennedy. David could serve as our on-

campus pastor in Boston. Another option is a small independent Baptist church in Providence. We could use an existing church in Boston, use the Pastor and staff from the small church in Providence, and stream the Sunday Morning Message either on Sunday afternoons, evenings or show the prior week's message on the following Saturday evening.

a. Anticipated congregation Year One: 100.

i. Perhaps more. When college students are confronted with the reality of Christianity and that faith is not blind, we see a spike in interest. There are 250,000 college students attending universities in the Boston area.

b. Radio ministry already in place via Reclaiming America for Christ Radio Network. \$72,000 for eleven hours M-F.

ADDITIONAL NOTE: I was contacted by Richard Tails on 10/15. Tails ~~Unscripted~~ is the Web's largest publishing house in America. Mr. Tails began the call with "We don't pursue projects. They come to us. However, we have been following your work for a while and we want to publish everything you're doing." Having received this solicitation and having a much larger exposure with church campuses in multiple states demonstrating what a preacher CANNOT do and should be doing, our model may put pressure on other pastors to get with it or lose their congregations.

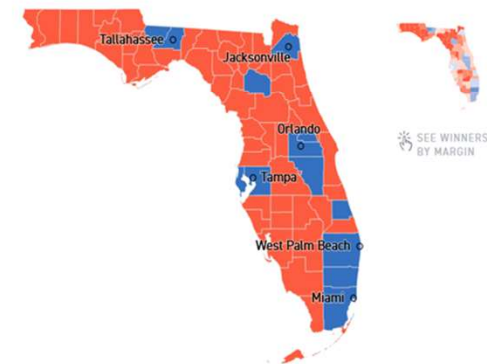
