


Rev 2:2-5










Acts 19:29-32



As I counseled you when I was leaving for Macedonia, stay on in Ephesus, so that you may order certain people who are teaching a different doctrine to stop. CJB


2 Cor 11:13-15






The Adversary's Attack on the local church:

 - b) Pride




Eph 4:30-32








1 Thess 4:9-12


