Heb 4:15 *For we have not an high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but **was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin.***



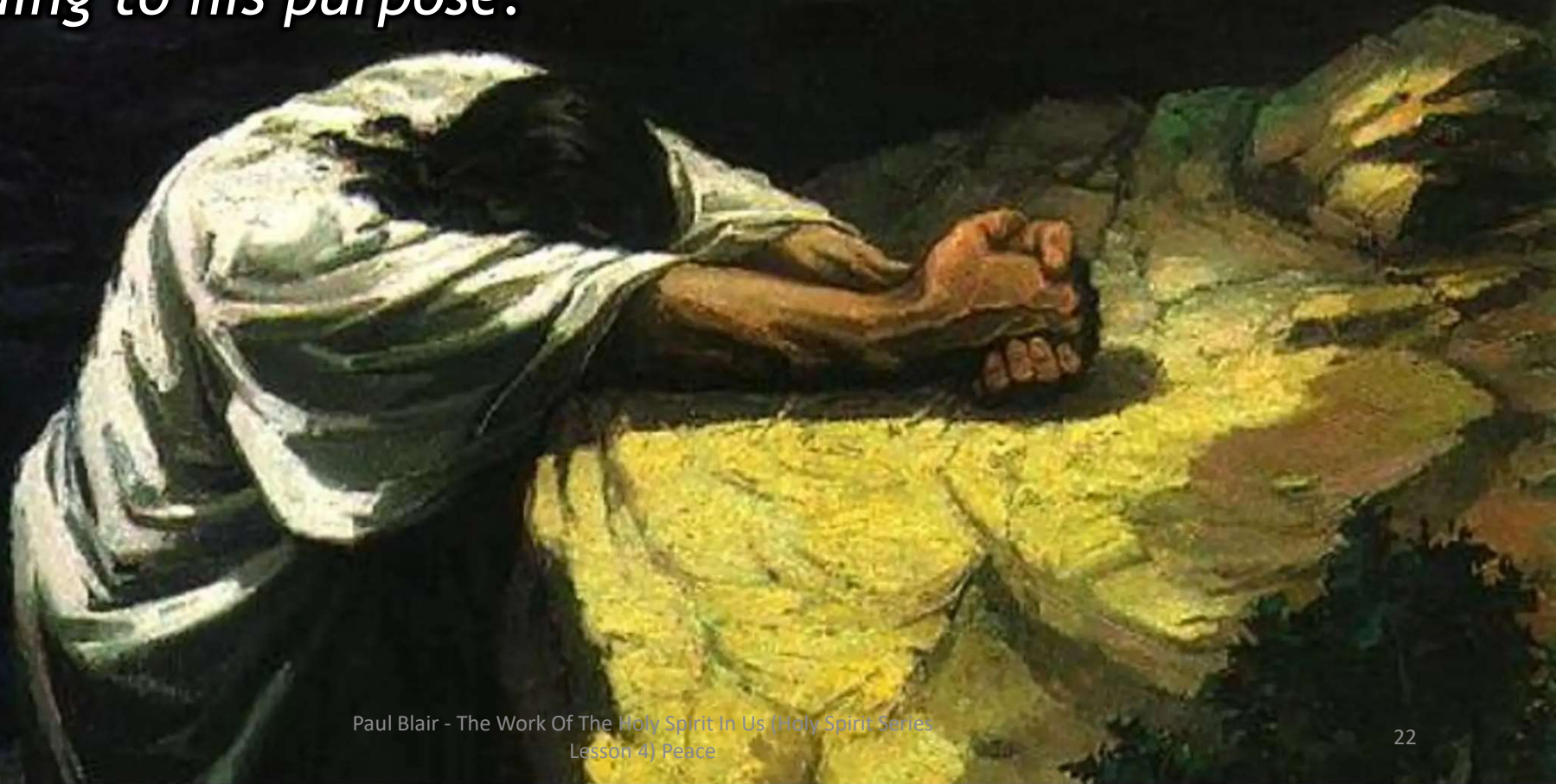
Psalm 23 *The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want.*

Rom 8:28 And we know that **all things work together for good to them that love God**, to them who are the called according to his purpose.



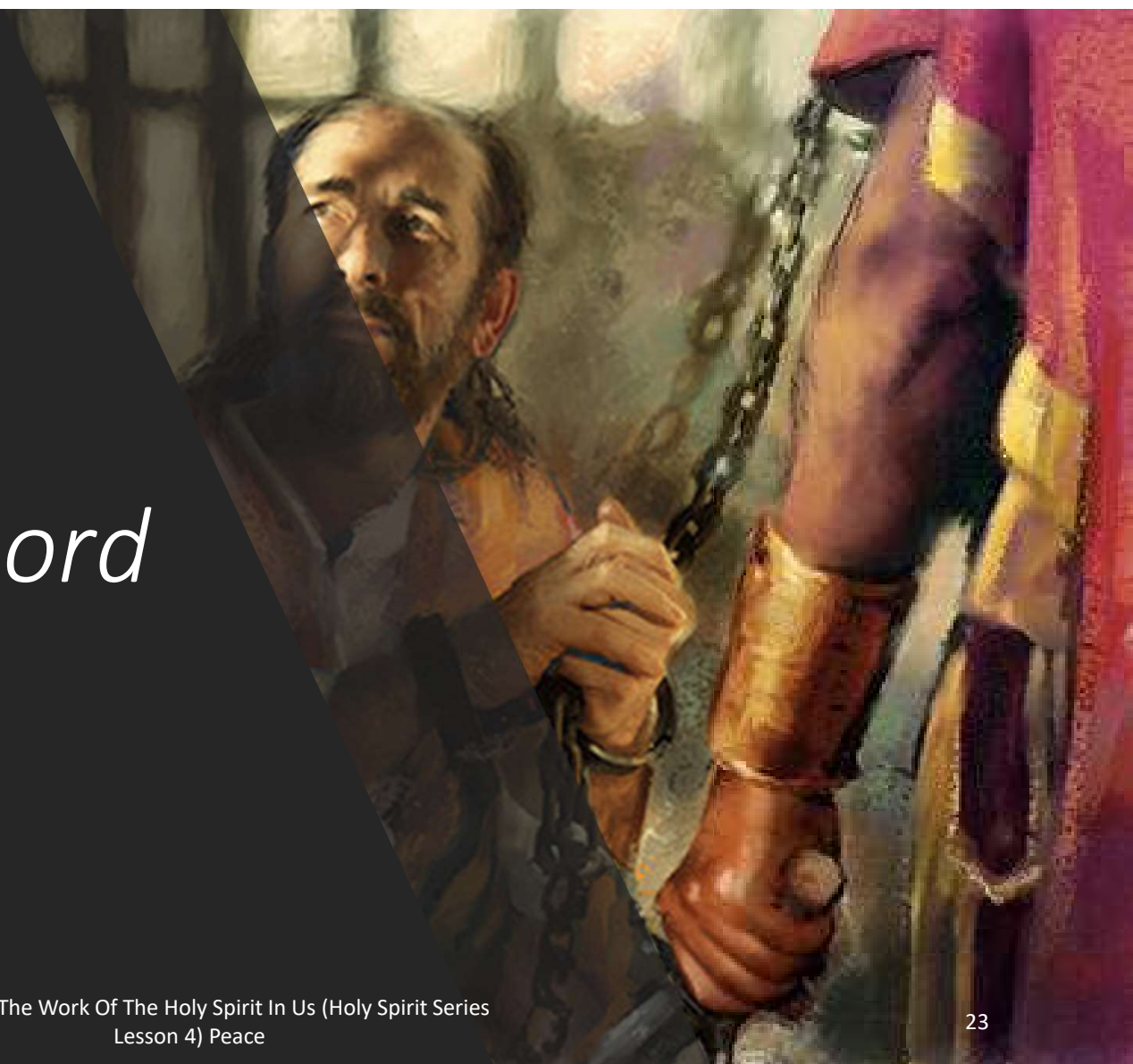

5. Glory of God.

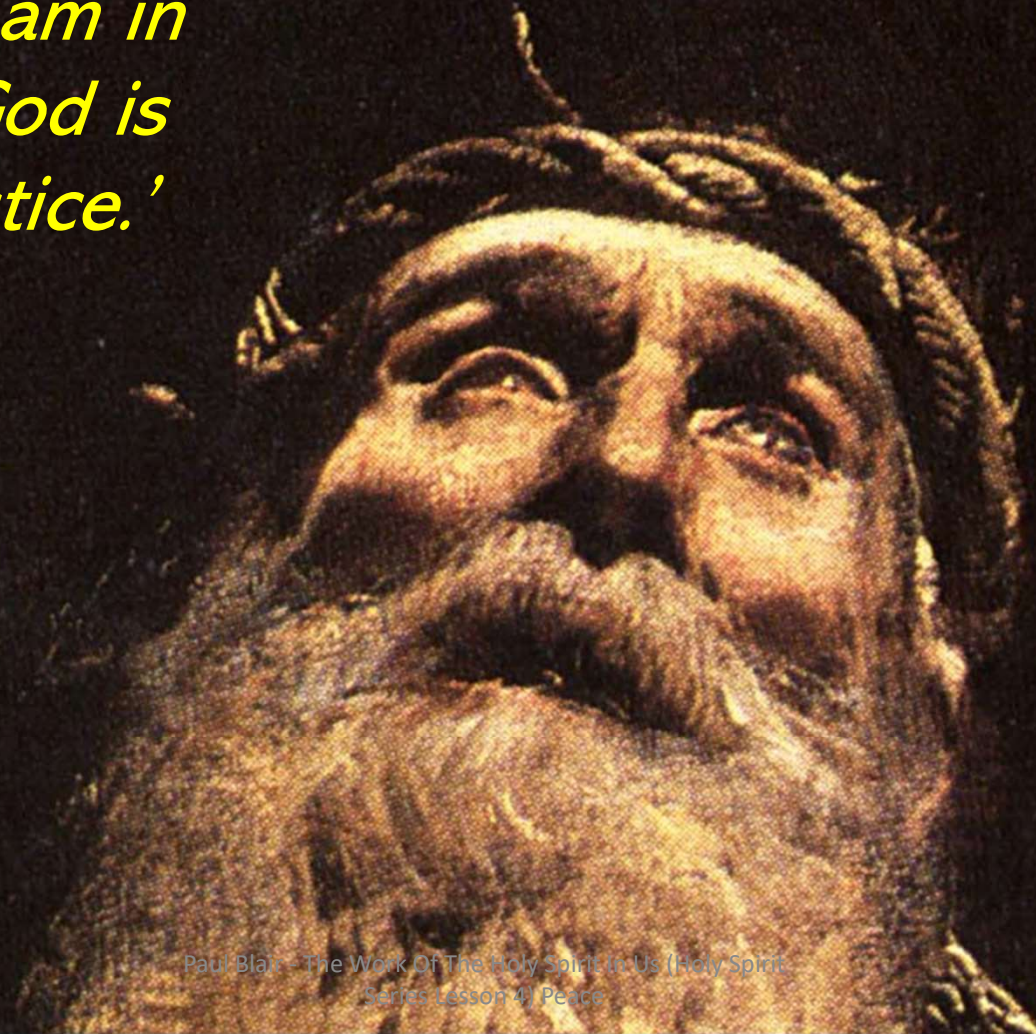

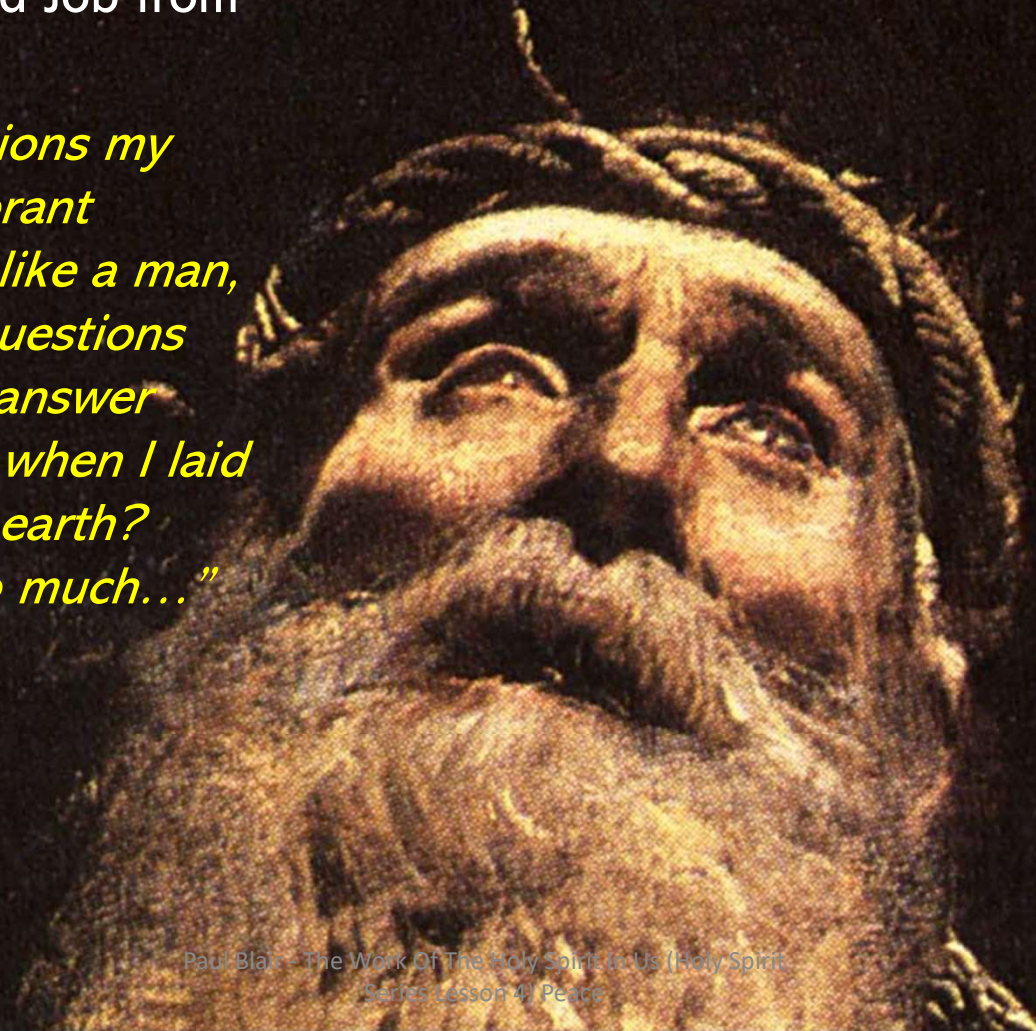

Then the Lord answered Job from the whirlwind:

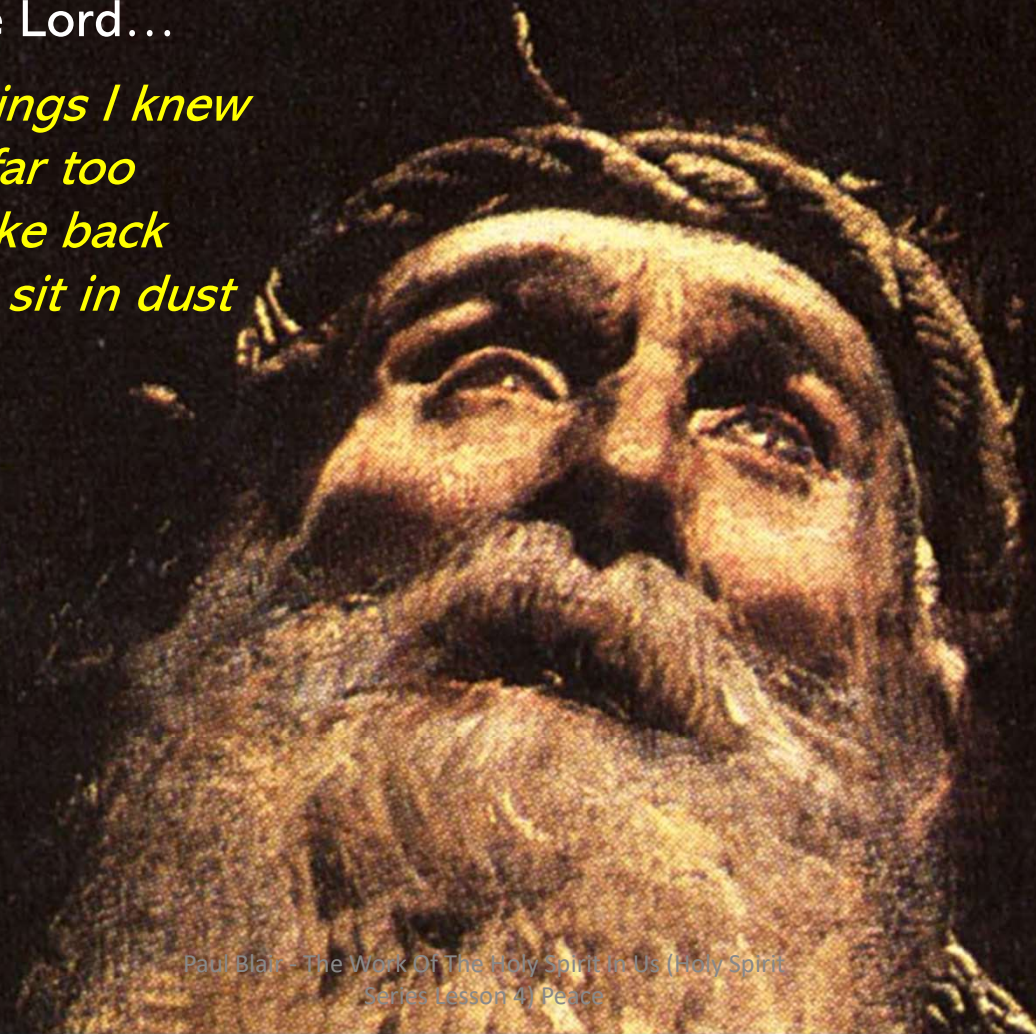

"I was talking about things I knew nothing about, things far too wonderful for me...I take back everything I said, and I sit in dust and ashes to show my repentance."






- Is it simply natural law? **TRUST GOD.**
